Bay View



Lets Go Fishing!

Almost completely surrounded by the waters of Sandusky Bay, Bay View has always been a fishing mecca. We are in the middle of a fertile breeding ground for nearly all the species of fish in Lake Erie. Perch, crappie, bass, and walleye breed in the Sandusky River, which flows via the Sandusky Bay to Lake Erie; right past Bay View, through a narrow channel. What we are best known for here is our huge channel catfish. Catching 15 pound plus catfish is routine and fish over 25 pounds is not uncommon. Fishing along the bank is easy and within access of everyone. You can even fish right across the street from the Bell. Inquire at the Bay View Center about our fisherman's parking lot.

Next to you, the Bay View Center Bait and Tackle Shop is ready to get you "hooked" up, for a fun day of fishing. We carry high quality gear and sell all the bait you could need! We even have rental rods, for those visiting. Stop in and browse about. We carry local artisan goods, food, and ice cream as well.

Did you know that Bay View is considered one of the top 5 catfishing holes in the United States, and #1 for channel cat in Ohio?

Finding the wildlife

A wide variety of avian species & unique mammals can also be seen in Bay View. Look around and enjoy views of bald eagles, deer, foxes, Canadian geese, some fancy geese, and more. You can also be lucky enough to spot a wild eastern turkey. If you drive to the back of the village and patiently circle the streets behind the Village Park, there is a good chance you will see the rare breeds of wild turkey that have inhabited the village for over a decade. They liked the neighborhood and decided to move in. Since they are protected on village land, they have found a safe haven from the local hunters. While often a nuisance, they are now a regal part of our village and a definite attraction. Be nice and keep your distance – at least 30 feet. While not known to attack, who wants to find out what those massive spurs are for.

Did you know that Bay View had an extensive carp fishery that at one time supplied almost all the fish to the delis of New York City, used for gefilte (stuffed) fish? It was shipped by railroad cars daily.

Enjoy a stroll

The village is very kind and quaint. A walk around the waterfront, the fishing pier, or the park, is a very peaceful way to spend an hour or so in a tranquil surrounding.

The "Front Bay" on E. Bayview Drive is the commercial zone where you are now and down the street is a popular Roadhouse Bar and Grill called Rayz on the Bay. The "Back Bay" is along W. Bayview Drive and houses a beautiful protected water that is a perfect place to water ski. It is lined with private docks, many of which have been artfully personalized.
