## C.O.M.O. Recovery

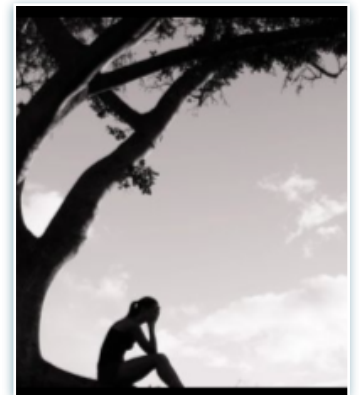
LONG TERM RESIDENTIAL RECOVERY COMMUNITY

- ▶ 75% retention rate *(75% of the people who come into the program and stay beyond stage 1 (induction) stay until graduation)*
- ▶ 90% of graduates are still sober five years post graduation
- ▶ 4 houses, minimum stay 18 months, 100% job placement/or college enrollment

## THREE

PROVIDES A SAFE ENVIRONMENT TO BUILD TRUST WITH WOMEN THAT ARE SEXUALLY EXPLOITED

- ▶ 23,000 visits to the center since opening in 2017
- ▶ 16,000 meals served in 2020
- ▶ 20 people receive medical assistance monthly *(including Narcan treatment)*



## TWO

A NON-JUDGEMENTAL PLACE WHERE MEN CAN COME IN AND RECEIVE BASIC NEEDS AND RESOURCES TO CULTIVATE LIFE CHANGE

- ▶ 8,800 visits to the center since opening in May 2019
- ▶ 5,300 meals served 2020
- ▶ 92 pieces of furniture/appliances provided through Furniture Bank
