

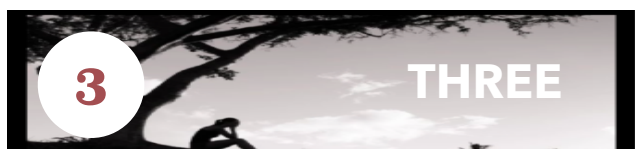


We provide support and assistance for victims of human trafficking, drug abuse and those immersed in poverty

- Men's Recovery House
- Women's Recovery Houses (3)
- Women's Crisis Room (transition space from the streets to recovery/safe living)
- Family (NA) Meeting (weekly - led by a parent of a graduate)
- C.O.M.O. Restoration - vocational training and job placement



- Open Tuesday 4-6 pm; Thursday 4-7 pm; Saturday 12n-4pm
- Provides clothes, showers, laundry, a hot meal, and a safe place to rest
- Columbus Fire Department REACT Team distributes resources and Narcan on site
- Specialized care in partnership with Southeast Mental Health
 - STD screening, prevention education and prep medication management (preventative HIV medication)
 - Twice weekly nurse on site distributes and manages preventative HIV medication, for positive HIV nurse manages HIV treatment



- Open Sunday 2-5 pm; Wednesday 5-7 pm
- Provides clothes, showers, a hot meal, and a safe place to rest
- Furniture Bank - through connection with LazyBoy and private donations we are able to offer furniture, and appliances to those in need, often those moving from shelters and recovery housing into residences.
