Meet Our Keynote Speaker: Nicole Braddock Bromley

Nicole Braddock Bromley is an international advocate on sexual abuse and trafficking. She has authored 4



books, produced 2 films and is co-host of the OneVOICE Podcast. In 2012, Nicole went undercover to the brothels of Cambodia, where she met with children who were stuck in the web of sex trafficking and helped them tell their stories for an international film project. In 2014, she founded a non-profit OneVOICE4freedom that stops child sex trafficking around the world through prevention education and care for the world's most vulnerable children and families. In 2020, Nicole launched UNLEASH, an 8-week e-course for healing from sexual abuse in all of it's forms, which includes a live online support community for survivors, and she leads their weekly zoom meetings. For 23 years, Nicole has traveled extensively as a voice of awareness, prevention, hope and healing to some of the most vulnerable populations around the world, as well as to some of the most prestigious universities, companies and conferences.

The audience will have a rare opportunity to engage in a meaningful Q&A session with Nicole and C.O.M.O. Executive Director Beth Tabor. Together, they will explore the deep connections between their work, shedding light on the shared mission of fighting human trafficking and addiction. While Nicole travels the world exposing the realities of sexual abuse and trafficking and offering resources for healing, Beth tackles these same issues right here in Central Ohio, providing recovery programs, shelters, and community support to those in need.
