Special 2025 ISS Enduro Rules Update

It is rare to make any changes Mid Season but effective immediately Nissan Altimas, prepared to the Freedom Factory Rules Package, are eligible for the remainder of the 2025 season in the Impact Survival Series. When queried about the rule change owner, Matt Rowe, explained "Cleetus McFarland has been doing a great job introducing an ISS style of racing to the entire country. Some of our competitors have even asked if he was at one of our races watching. While we didn't notice him at any of our events we do stream all of our races at www.ISSracing.TV and a number of competitors upload their own versions (Lots of in Car GO-Pro footage) to Cleetus's preferred platform, YouTube. Regardless we believe this format is the best racing in the Nation and have been promoting these races for 16 years now. We have produced some of the best Enduro racers in the nation and hope to have a few of our Stars compete in his next Florida based event - currently scheduled for Oct 11th. Allowing the Altima in the ISS series would give our guys an opportunity to shake down and familiarize themselves with the Altima platform. Additionally we would provide an opportunity for countless Altima drivers to get more seat time in the fast paced and ever changing obstacle course that ensues. It's a win win. We applaud Cleetus for his successes and if we can harness any of the momentum he has created that's a big win for our regional series. He has the whole country's attention right now with simple Grass Roots racing. The season highlights include our first ever trip, on July 19th, to The Raceway at Beaver Dam which is unfortunately closing at years end and another first, a two part event, the first half on the Blacktop Surface at Wisconsin International Raceway and then, just a few hours later the same race concludes on the high banked clay at the 141 Speedway on September 20th.
