The Dynamite Destruction Derby is an entertaining event of 'Stupid Car Tricks', abnormal racing events, and challenging contests. It is NOT a Demo Derby.

Basic Rules on Attitude & Conduct: NO obscene or inappropriate writing or symbols allowed. We are here to have fun, any inappropriate behavior can result in expulsion and loss of any monies.

Car Eligibility: 4 or 6 cylinder Unibody cars only.
Two wheel drive ONLY

Air Bags: Driver side airbags must be removed and system disabled.

Back Brace Bar: All cars must have a bar of at least 1 ½ inch diameter running from B pillar to B Pillar directly behind the driver's seat. All seats must have a rear head support (factory headrest is fine). Bar MUST be padded using upholstery Not foam rubber.

Battery location/covering/securing: Battery must be covered. Battery may be relocated but then it must be housed in a plastic battery box and securely fastened to the floor.

Bumpers: Bumpers must be approved OEM in OEM location, welded, chained or cabled to frame. If there is an easy way for the tow truck to wrap around your bumper and lift great. Otherwise you MUST add tow hooks.

Brake Systems: Operational brakes are required at all times.

Dashboard: Must remain in place.

Doors: NO gutting of doors allowed. Factory internal supports/structures must be retained.

Recommended: 1/8" plate welded to the outside of the door forward and back of the door jamb.

Recommended: Leaving factory interior door panel to cover sharp edges.

Gas Systems: Gas system must remain stock if possible. Small boat tanks will be allowed when located between the rear wheels but they must be properly secured and a rear firewall or cover will be mandatory. Fuel line may pass through the driver's compartment but then must be in a sealed conduit. Fuel pump and gas lines MUST be outside the driving compartment.

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Exhaust: Must exit behind the driver.

Glass/Trim/Headlights: Must be removed before coming to the track.

Radiator: Radiator must remain in stock location and may have a maximum of 1 bar added for protection. Any reinforcing deemed excessive will be cut off before the car is allowed to compete.

Sunroofs & T-Tops: Must be tinned over.

Suspension: Must remain stock.

Body: All trailer hitches and receivers must be removed. All sharp edges on body must be fixed.

Tires: Must be passenger car tires.

Windshields: Are to remain in car unless severely spidered. If replaced, a welded wire or expanded metal screen reinforced with three (3) braces are required to protect the driver. Braces will be a minimum of 3/8" and go from the roof to the firewall.

Wheel Weights: All wheel weights must be removed.

Roof Mounted Number Panel Required: Must be 12 inches high and a minimum of 24 inches long. Must be mounted in the center of the roof, with the long center of the roof with the long dimension running from the front of roof to back and painted black. Do NOT cut the roof to make the fin. Your assigned scoring number will be painted on this panel. You will also need to remember this number for payout.

Driver Eligibility: You must be 18 to compete. 16 & 17 year olds can compete with properly filled out Minor Release forms – one from each parent unless both parents will be in attendance. If parents are not in attendance the forms will need to be notarized so DO NOT WAIT UNTIL RACE DAY! We can mail or email you the proper forms.

Helmet: Good quality DOT approved helmet in good condition is required.

Raceceiver: Raceceiver radio set to the default channel 000 (454.000) is required. If you do not have a raceceiver, they will be available for rent for \$10. Bring a good set of earbuds along – a limited supply of earbuds may be available for purchase.

Driver Suit Recommended: Long sleeved shirts and long pants required. NO open toed shoes allowed.

Goggles/Eye Protection: Required at all times.

Gloves: Required. Fire retardant gloves recommended.
