

## WRECKING CREW

#### **Attendance Guidelines**

Wrecking Crew Member are expected to be at all Command Crew & Temple Functions.

The Secretary of the Wrecking Crew will be notified "in advance" if the member has a conflict with attendance at any Wrecking Crew Command Function. This notification is for man-power logistics only and is not an excuse for failure of attendance.

If a Wrecking Crew member misses more than Three (3) full Wrecking Crew Commands with any 6-month period, the member shall be brought before The Board to explain members actions.

The Board will determine appropriate action depending on the situation and assurances that the lack of participation will not be an ongoing problem. Appropriate action may consist of fines to expulsion.

 Leave of Absence – Can be granted by the Board of Directors for a period not to exceed 6 months (Exception being active Military Duty). Member has to send a letter to Secretary and appear before the Board of Directors at the next scheduled Board Meeting.

During a Leave of Absence – There is no credit towards moving to Veteran Status.



## FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS OF PROBATIONARY AND REGULAR MEMBERS

- 1. YEARLY DUES: Probationary and Regular members shall pay \$25 at the January Meeting.
- 2. **ATTENDANCE:** Probationary and Regular members are expected to be at **all Commands**. More than three (3) no shows in a six-month period shall result in an appearance before the Board of Directors to discuss the problem.
- 3. **MONTHLY MEETINGS:** Probationary and Regular members shall attend 10 Regular Meetings (including dinner and "Attitude Adjustment") at \$30 and 2 Summer meetings (June and August) at \$50, which includes you and a guest (whether you bring one or not.)
- 4. **OTHER COMMANDS:** Probationary and Regular members shall attend parades, picnic, Youth Shrine Bowl, fund raisers, Stunt Check-Outs, and other events as designated by the President. Failure to Appear Fines of \$10 to \$50 or more will be issued to those who do not appear.
- 5. **UNIFORM:** Approximately \$150 for hat, shirts, and jacket used at most parades, Shrine, or CREW events. Purchase white painter coveralls for Ceremonials.
- 6. **LADIES NIGHT:** All members shall pay \$100-125 for a party at the Temple or \$150-175 for a party offsite. If the Probationary or Regular member is not able to make it to the event they shall pay \$50 for the Ladies Gift. (Note: This is a Formal Event and most of the cost is subsidized by the proceeds from fund raisers.)
- 7. **CEREMONIALS:** Attendance at the Second Section of the Ceremonial is **Mandatory** for all Probationary and Regular members. If a Probationary or Regular member does not attend (**no excuses are valid**) a fine of \$100 shall be issued. The Secretary shall promptly notify members when Ceremonials are scheduled or rescheduled
- 8. **POTENTATE VISIT:** Probationary and Regular members shall pay \$30 for each ticket. This event is attended by the CREW and their Ladies, veteran members and their Ladies, and the Divan. A fine of \$60 shall be issued to Probationary and Regular members for not attending.
- 9. **CRAB FEED:** Probationary and Regular members shall be billed \$600 and will receive ten (10) \$50 tickets. (Note: The additional \$100 shall be the members raffle contribution. A Probationary and Regular member may bring an item, of equal or greater value, to the September Meeting with the approval of the President in lieu of paying the \$100.) Members who sell more than ten (10) tickets shall receive a \$10 credit towards their raffle contribution for every ticket they sell beyond their initial ten (10) tickets.

Note: All fees and fines will come back to the CREW in the form of an open bar at most functions and fully or partially subsidized trips, parties, and cash donations to the Temple and the Hospital.

#### **PROBIE & APPLICANT GUIDELINE**

#### **General Rules of Membership**

- 1. Bylaws Limit Crew to 30 regular members, 15 Probie Members & Unlimited Applicant Members.
- 2. Probie Members Must Serve One Year, Applicant Members Three Months.
- 3. Advancement to Probie is by Seniority and Board Approval and Only When a Position Becomes Available.
- 4. Advancement to Regular Member is by Seniority, Board Approval, and Election of the General Membership and Only When a Position Becomes Available.

#### **General Duties & Expectations**

- 1. All the Duties Expected of a Regular Member Including Fees for Meetings & Events, Fines, Ticket Sales, and Attendance.
- 2. All the Requirements of Any Assigned Duty.
- 3. Any other Duties Assigned by the President, Director, or Potentate.
- 4. Attendance or valid written excuse is required at all commands.

- 5. Failure to Attend or Submit Valid Written Notice is Cause for Being Dropped For Consideration to Membership.
- 6. When a Proble Member is elected to Regular Membership He is expected to put on a Party for the Regular Members on the Night of the Election.
- 7. Knowledge of the Rules and By-Laws of the Wrecking Crew.

#### **Monthly Duties and Expectations**

- 1. Clean up after all Monthly Crew Meetings at the Direction of the Vice President.
- 2. Attend all Board Meetings if deemed appropriate by the President.
- 3. Any Other Duties Assigned by the President, Director, or Potentate.

#### Special Conditions for Applicant with Less Than Four Months Seniority

- 1. They Are Not Required to Bring or Pay For Guest at Summer Meetings.
- 2. They Are Not Required to Have Ceremonial or Parade Uniform.
- 3. Then Are Not Required to Sell the Minimum Number of Fund Raiser Tickets.
- 4. They Are Not Eligible for Crew Event Travel Subsidies.
