Look through your stash and see if you have any batiks.


Bring 1-5 batik Fat Quarters to the OQSO retreat.

JUMP START YOUR CREATIVITY

Workshop Description:

This technique is for the quilter that is ready to break out of the box and experience a playful way of creating. Too much thinking or fear often stops quilters from trying new designs and fabrics. A simple flower pattern is the first ingredient, a wide array of wild, powerful & playful novelty fabrics (polka dots, geometrics, floral's, etc.) and few solid fabrics is the second ingredient and willing spirit is the third ingredient. A pattern will be provided





This simple baby quilt or gift quilt comes together fast! 3 colors, easy piecing and some appliqué hearts make an adorable "Baby's first quilt" or an "" gift. The saw tooth border is a little time-consuming, but can be replaced with simple borders (options given in class). – From the book Hearts Aplenty by Llynda Milligan and Nancy Smith.



This is a great quilt to make if you want to put a dent in your stash. Using 2.5" squares, 2.5" strips, and 4.5" Squares, we will make a fun quilt using a partial seam allowance technique. You can easily change the size of the quilt with the number of blocks you can make. I challenge you to dig into your stash and lets make a one of a kind quilt. If you have jelly rolls in your stash, I guess you can sneak them in, but you will still need to find those 4.5" squares. I love working on this quilt.
