

FLOATING STAR BLOCK

This is a super simple block provided by Phyllis Enos. I've made it three and it is super simple. You do not have to use this block pattern if you don't choose to. It should be 12 1/2" unfinished. Please use white to off white background with blue and red for the star. If you want to make several blocks, that's GREAT! If it's possible try to mix the fabrics up so we don't have lots of blocks exactly the same. It makes for a more interesting quilt when they are put together.



For (1) 12 1/2" block you will need:

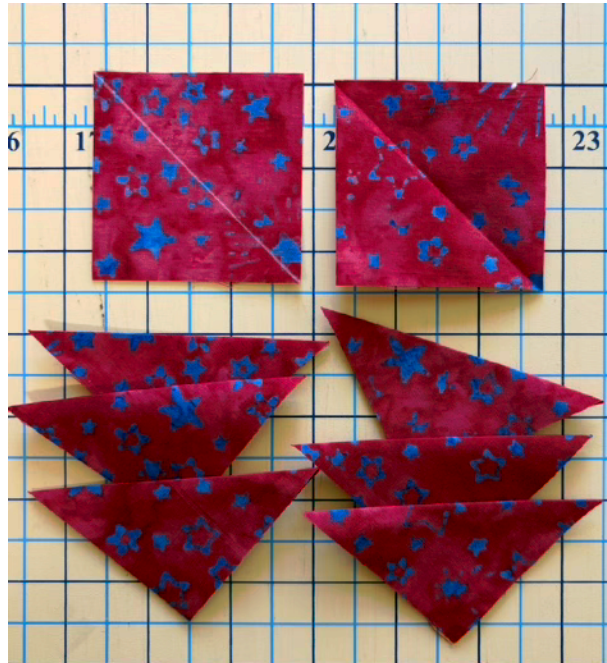
From the white to cream fabric cut (4) 4" X 5 1/2" rectangles and (4) 4" squares.

From the center blue cut (1) 5 1/2" square.

From the red cut (8) 2 1/2" squares.

For the Star Point units look at the diagram on the net page. You can draw a line corner to corner on the wrong side of the fabric or you

can just press a crease in each square and follow the fold when sewing. Trim to 1/4" and press seams open. You should have (4) start units.



Arrange your units according to the diagram. Press the top and bottom vertical row seams out and the middle vertical row seams in, press the top and bottom horizontal seams to the middle, according to the photos. Flip the block right side up and give it one more press.
