

## 2.18.20 SCPC Meeting Minutes

President Clark Brody called the meeting to order at 1pm.

Financial Report was approved.

### Business Discussed

- Clark, Bruce, Bob K. and Jennifer H. met with Sup. Curt Scholl to discuss original plan to use SES tennis courts and also potential permanent location next to SMS. In response, Curt proposed grassy area between parking lot and old tennis courts for future PB. *IF* a school bond measure passes in 5/2021, and *if* the ODOT round about design plan will not infringe on that space.
- In the meantime, it may be possible to convert the SES courts for PB using lowered, existing nets for 2 courts for public use temporarily. We are awaiting a response from Jennifer on drafting a Memo of Understanding between SPRD and SSD with regards to maintenance.
- The Club is exploring the possibility of partnering with Sage Meadows which would allow SCPC members to purchase a membership (\$90) that would allow for dedicated SCPC play—with a \$75 portion going to SM for court usage and maintenance. Details still need to be worked out.
- *Pickleball Skills Classes:* Ideas to restructure and level classes for both newer players and more advanced players using a self rating rubric for future classes. Also discussed:
  1. Limit class size to 12
  2. Use Sign Up Genius for each leveled group
  3. Provide sign up sheet each night for data gathering
  4. Have donation box for SCPC facility rental/other
- Pickleball Quarterly Newsletter will build relationships with members and the public. Clark will use a template to create the newsletter (dates to be determined) with content sent to him by members.
- Met with Toni and Bev of Age Friendly Community to talk about ways to work with/support each other. Looking for grant writing opportunities.
- Tate from Sisters Athletic Club offered to sell land zoned for courts, but we are not in a position to purchase them.
- BBR homeowners can invite club members for play/gathering. Will plan event at our next meeting.
- Looking into using the Group Me app as an opt-in perk of membership. To promote communication among players and publicize upcoming events/classes.

### Action Items

- Robin will create binder with meeting minutes and agendas.
- Clark and Bruce will meet with SPRD and City 2/20 to discuss temporary courts.
- Robin to create a planning list of actions when setting up pickleball clinics.
