The Airfields Memorial is dedicated to the Servicemen and Women who served on the twelve New Forest airfields during the Second World War.

We hold an annual service there, attended by Service representatives and fly the flags of all the nations who served. In addition, The Memorial enclosure is also dressed for United States Memorial Day and for Remembrance Sunday.

The Heritage Centre is divided into sections devoted to individual airfields, in the ground floor hall.

Display panels describe the aircraft and aircrew, including a section on the East Boldre training airfield used during the First World War.

The upstairs gallery contains prints signed by WWII pilots and ground crew who served here.
