Director's Notes



JEREMY WALKER

Guys and Dolls is a classic! It is considered by many to be one of the greatest musicals of all time and stands the test of time! A story filled with romance, everlasting love and commitment, comedy, heart, and incredible characters, all dice rolled together with some of the most recognizable songs of all time!

As Artistic Director with FRC, this show has been on my to-do list for some time, but I just couldn't find the right fit in our seasons. When Misfit and Morpheus announced they were doing it, I jumped at the chance

to audition and was awarded the role of Nicely Nicely Johnson. Then comes the day before the first read-through, and I receive a call from Krista, Misfit Theatre's Artistic Director. The company had decided to make a directing change, and I was asked to fill the role. Now, directing is something I have done a lot over the years, but I had decided to take a break from it and get back into performing more. With the read-through less than 24 hours away, I did not have a long time to think about it.

A director normally does a lot of pre-work going into a show, often spending weeks, months and even years leading up to the auditions. Many meetings with design team members take place during that time and ideas come and go on the direction to take the show. You then go through the audition process and cast your show with your choreographer and music director. In this situation, I was going to be getting in the director's chair, having not been a part of any design meetings with a company I had not worked with before and a mostly inherited cast that I had no say in. I also had not thought of my ideas on what to do with this show.

Naturally, I jumped in feet first!

This show has pushed me as a director to find ways to get where I want it to be and catch up on the months I would have been prepping! It has been very rewarding, and I was lucky enough to be surrounded by some incredibly supportive people both on and off the stage!

I hope you enjoy our take on this classic as it was built with all the blood, sweat, tears and, most importantly, heart of everyone involved!
