

**RESOLUTION OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF
BLACK CANYON IRRIGATION DISTRICT**

It is hereby resolved that Black Canyon Irrigation District shall and does hereby create an exchange policy facilitated by the Black Canyon Irrigation District in order to accomplish the greatest beneficial use of the waters available to the members of the Black Canyon Irrigation District.

In any year when a member of the Black Canyon Irrigation District determines that the member will not irrigate a given number of acres that they have the right to irrigate. That individual may contact the office of the Black Canyon Irrigation District and sign a certificate as approved by the Board of Directors of the Black Canyon Irrigation District, asserting that they will keep those acres dry and will not irrigate them during that year's irrigation season. This transfer, however, must be to lands that can physically receive the water and that are on the same type of delivery system as the lands that are to remain dry during that irrigation season with an individual who has lands within the District that they desire to irrigate during that irrigation season.

A description of the land, including the metes and bounds, or other description deemed acceptable to the District, of the land to be dried up and the land to which the water is being transferred must be submitted with the application to transfer.

The account must be paid in full at the time the request is made and all federally required paperwork must be completed.

An administrative fee of \$200.00 must be paid to the Black Canyon Irrigation District at the time the transfer request is filed with the District office. Transfer requests must be filed, and all fees paid before February 1st of any irrigation year. \$50.00 per month will be added to the administrative fee if the forms are not filed before February 1st.

If the land to which water is to be transferred is not classified and the land is greater than five acres, then a \$200.00 reclassification fee must be paid. The expenses incurred by the Black Canyon Irrigation District to reclassify shall also be paid by the individual seeking the transfer.

Any transfer of water usage must be approved as being able to be accomplished by existing infrastructure of the Black Canyon Irrigation District.

No transfer of water usage may be made to lands lying outside of the Black Canyon Irrigation District.
