Once approved, your dog will be added to the queue for delivery or pick up. If the dog is already in Canadian Foster Care, this will be rather quick.

The adoption agreement must be completed, signed and received by the Bruno Project St Lucia at [stluciaanimals@hotmail.com](mailto:stluciaanimals@hotmail.com) and adoption fee must be paid in full before the dog is passed to the adopters. Adoption fees are to be paid by e-transfer to [brunoprojectstlucia@gmail.com](mailto:brunoprojectstlucia@gmail.com). Please mention in comments that it is an adoption fee and the name of the dog (if possible). The security answer does not have to be passed along until our Canadian volunteers are present to deliver the dog but the fee must be deposited before the dog is left with the new adopter. Adoption fees are not to be paid directly to the foster home in Canada or to any of our Canadian volunteers unless prior agreement was reached with the President of Bruno Project St Lucia. No more than two dogs from Bruno Project/SLAPS will be adopted to the same household.
