Completed applications forms can be e-mailed to <u>stluciaanimals@hotmail.com</u> If this paper application is approved a home visit will be conducted. Once approved, you will be added to a Facebook group where we post incoming dogs and you will be given the opportunity to comment on the post if you are willing to foster.

Our dogs are imported into Canada with all the vaccinations required by Canadian Food Inspection Agency and if over 16 weeks normally have received the rabies vaccine. All our dogs are treated with prophylactics against worms, ticks, and flees prior to export from St Lucia. Normally dogs over 5 months old arrive already spayed/neutered. Average St Lucian dogs are about 40 lbs full grown but we have some adult dogs as small as 10 or 65 lbs on occasion.

The foster home agreement must be completed, signed and received by the Bruno Project St Lucia at <u>stluciaanimals@hotmail.com</u>. While fostering if you find a home for your foster, the new home must apply in writing on our application forms and must be completely screened and fee paid before you hand over the dog to them, regardless of your relationship with them.
