

For Everyone's Enjoyment & Safety Please Take a Moment to Familiarize Yourself With:

BUMP's FACILITY GUIDELINES

1. All BUMP facility & Sanctioning Bodies Code of Conduct rules apply.
2. Hours of operation subject to change – riding during facility closures is trespassing.
3. Immediately upon arrival all persons riding or visiting BUMP must register & sign all appropriate waivers.
4. **Helmets must be worn at all times when on a machine, including doubling of passengers to/from viewing areas. This includes parents on minibikes.**
5. Crossing of RR14 only at designated area(s), no riding in ditches or on RR14
6. First gear **SLOW** in pit area and while crossing RR14 - **NO PIT RIDING OR STUNTING.**
7. BUMP is not a babysitting service. Minors are to be supervised by a responsible adult that has legal signing authority at all times while on premise.
8. **NO LITTERING**; this includes discarding cigarette butts on ground. All garbage must be removed by the originating party, including animal waste.
9. **Outside of pit area, the following is not permitted:**
 - a. Smoking - only by your vehicle - no butts on ground
 - b. Touching/climbing on/standing on/vandalizing BUMP equipment & property – this is considered trespassing.
10. Pets are welcome but please ensure the following:
 - a. Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pet.
 - b. Animals must be controlled or removed from BUMP premises. Animals displaying aggressive or uncontrollable behavior will be asked to leave the facility at the discretion of BUMP.
 - c. All animals to be on a leash at all times,
 - d. **ALL DOGS MUST REMAIN AT VEHICLE**
11. A person who consumes an intoxicant such as alcohol & drugs (incl. Cannabis) is not permitted to ride or do any type of mechanical work to any machine.
 - a. Alcohol permitted in pit area only after all riding/mechanical is completed by persons age 18 or older as applicable by law.
12. No fires permitted except in designated area(s). Firewood must be small enough to fit inside the fire pit
 - a. You are responsible for any fires that you/your group starts.
 - b. Wood only in fire pit. No gas, garbage, bottles, cans etc
 - c. All fire restrictions or bans must be obeyed.
 - d. Fires must be completely extinguished before being left unattended (departure, sleeping, riding, etc.).
13. No admittance to any barn yards &/or farm buildings/corrals.
14. Please be considerate of our facility in addition to our neighbors, the County, and other visitors to BUMP. BUMP will not be held responsible for loss or damage incurred during your visit.

**ZERO TOLERANCE FOR ANY TYPE OF ABUSE. VIOLATION OF RULES OR REGULATIONS MAY RESULT IN REVOCATION OF RIDING PRIVILEGES.
NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.**

MOTOCROSS TRACKS

1. **MAIN / EXPERT (FRANK) TRACK & SPRINT/START TRACK**
 - a. West & South of BUMP house
 - b. Elevation changes; jumps; step-ups/downs/ rockers etc.
 - c. CLOCKWISE direction
 - d. **No stopping on main track / no unnecessary blocking**
 - e. All riders must ride complete track
 - i. No Cutting Track! (this causes drainage issues)
 - ii. If a rider is unable to roll **all** obstacles and must leave/re enter the track to ride it, see rule f below.
 - f. **Small wheels & novice riders require BUMP permission to be on this track each visit.**
 - g. Bikes only; no quads permitted
2. **INTERMEDIATE (ELISABETH) TRACK:**
 - a. South of BUMP house
 - i. Counter clockwise direction
 - ii. Elevation changes; small jumps
 - iii. Fast riders must exit if ladies or slower riders on track
3. **PEE WEE (ADVANCED) TRACK #2**
 - a. West & North of BUMP house beside pit area
 - b. Counter clockwise direction
 - c. Some elevation changes; no jumps
4. **PEE WEE (STARTER) TRACK #1**
 - a. North of Pee Wee #2 (Advanced) track
 - b. Counter clockwise direction
 - c. Very slight elevation changes; no jumps
5. **UNMAINTAINED – ABANDONED TRACK; QUADS/UTV PERMITTED**
 - a. East of BUMP house across RR14
 - b. Counter clockwise direction
 - c. Cross RR14 **only** at designated crossing(s)

TRAILS

**** If rider(s) go on any of the motocross tracks;**

- *Must yield to all track riders*
- *Must obey all rules as per the specific track they are entering*

1. **EASIER TRAILS**
 - a. Located Northwest of BUMP house
2. **MODERATE TRAILS**
 - a. Located East of BUMP house
 - i. See rules for Crossing RR14 appropriately
3. **DIFFICULT TRAILS**
 - a. Located south of Frank & Elisabeth's motocross tracks
