The declaration of a local disaster activates applicable provisions of local or interjurisdictional emergency management plans and authorizes the furnishing of aid and assistance under the declaration. *Id* §418.108(d). A disaster declaration lasts for no more than seven days unless continued or renewed by city council or a joint board, as applicable. *Id.* §418.108(b).
