

Dear Silver Springs Lake Community Lot Owners and Association Members:

Following several recent requests for access to Lot Owner Directories with private email and phone number contact information, the Lake Board and our website administrator looked for and found a new way to make this private information available to our Association Members - through a new and 'secure' website information channel.

This past June, the Association Member Directories, password-protected Microsoft spreadsheets with private phone numbers and email addresses, were removed from the Silver Springs Lake Association website. The Lake Board did this amid recent concerns about unauthorized electronic and telephone phishing abuses. They were replaced with .pdf files containing only public information. These directories are still available on the silverspringslake.com website for anyone to view.

A secure mechanism was identified that will allow authorized lot owners and their proxies (only) to access new password-secured directories, which contain our lot owners' private contact information, as before. The Association website has been modified accordingly. These Private Lot Owner Directory Listings are ready to use!

To access the Private Pages, send an email titled 'Request for Addition to the Approved User List' to info@silverspringsneshkoro.com or though the Contact Us page on the Association website (both go to the same in-box.)

Following approval, lot owners will receive an invitation from GoDaddy, our website hosting provider, to create a website password and user profile. After registering and creating your password, go to the Association website, www.silverspringsneshkoro.com, and use your email and password to log in, as prompted. To gain access to the private directory information, click the "Private Directories" item from the drop-down menu called "Resources."

The Lake Board appreciates your patience in our never-ending quest to better serve our community, and we welcome your comments and assistance.
