Our war against the lake weeds continues. The initial survey of the lake appears to be better than last year at this time; however, we have a long battle ahead of us. How it plays out for the year depends on the amount of sunlight and the temperatures. Cason Land and Water Management will monitor our lake during the summer and take appropriate actions to ensure a great boating season.

Everyone can contribute to the health of our lake and to the health of our fish population. Our jewel is a No Wake Lake. Mother Nature pounds our shores with storms, we don't need to add to the problem with excess wakes. Another way we can maintain our lake is to not bring in outside sand to add to your shoreline. This aids in stopping excess sand from filling in the lake and making it shallower. It is better to reclaim the sand from the lake. Help us manage our fish population by reporting your catches to board members.



Our annual meeting will be held on May 27th at 1:00 pm at St. James Church in Neshkoro.

Our annual meeting is coming up this Memorial Day Weekend. Several important issues concerning the future of our lake will be on the agenda. I am establishing a committee to investigate bringing back aeration to the lake. We need to determine if aeration will help with our muck and clarity problems. I am also establishing a committee to review our architectural bylaws, written over 40 years ago, to ensure continued relevance to today's residents and lifestyles. The committee will review and compare our bylaws as compared with other similar lake communities. We need to do everything we can to ensure we leave our jewel in good shape for the next generation.


