May 27, 2026 @ 1:00 p.m.

Recap Lake Annual Meeting (Budget \$250) was held on **Saturday, May 23, 2026 @ 9:00 a.m.** at the Neshkoro Community Center. Committee provided coffee and doughnuts. Pam Minarik brought coffee, cream and sugar and started the coffee by 8:00 with Deb Smith who brought cups and napkins; Nancy Adkins got 5 dozen doughnuts. Deb announced that we are in need for a Chairperson for the Fishing Jamboree on September 6th or the event will not happen. Also needed are Host Homes for the Poker Run on September 12th for Mint and Bass Bays, Pirates Cove and Breezy Cove. Recommendations for next year: **Have name tags** and stirrer sticks for the coffee.

Rummage Sale June 6th, 2026 (\$50 Budget) John/Karen Pape (Lot 53) Chair this event this year. Deb put the advertising in the Resorter and Billboard papers. Cedar Springs has already paid Deb for half of the bill. John and Karen Pape will put out signs on the day of the event. They will go around the lake and evaluate the success of the event and if it is worth the lake participating in future years. Deb is putting ads on 4 or 5 internet pages to invite people to come and shop, i.e. Wautoma, Berlin etc.

Golf Outing (\$500 Budget) **Saturday June 20, 2026** Steve Manlick (Lot 136) has volunteered to chair this event. He will coordinate all the golf pieces and give out the prizes after dinner (if there is not enough time before dinner). Sue and/or Steve Weihert will sell the 50/50 Raffle tickets with proceeds going to the Neshkoro Fire Department for the new equipment they need to purchase. Deb to make up a sign so people know it's for a good cause!

Dinner only \$20 (you don't have to be a golfer to enjoy dinner with friends)

But our committee was not established to chair all the events.
