Are guardians and group leaders allowed to take photos and videos during the workshop?	There is no photography or videography allowed during the workshop, however, the VIP package grants you access to all photos or videos taken by the crew during the workshop.

How far in advance should I reserve the studio?	We recommend you reserve your time slot no less than 2 weeks in advance to ensure availability.
What is the minimum and maximum number of students per workshop?	For our workshops, we require groups to be at least 4 students, but no more than 30 students.
