- Stabilizing violent or threatening situations
- Helping you identify your resources for care

- Talking about your worries about a loved one
- Talking about thoughts of suicide
- Getting you somewhere that's safe
- Providing emotional support to children who have been removed from their homes
- Presenting options for dealing with urgent situations
