


Budget Submission to GTC

Meeting with Mayor and General Manager

Weymouth Progress Association Inc. Spring 2024 Number 6

At the regular meeting with the Mayor and General Manager of the GTC and Chairs of the local Progress Associations, last held on July 25, Mayor Greg Kieser advised that \$150,000 has been allocated in this year's budget to progress the Township Character Plans. The items listed as high priorities on each of the Township Character Plans will be initially supported, however this does not mean that all priorities will be fully funded at this stage. An Action Plan will be developed by Council following the August Council Workshop. Future budget allocations will support further implementation initiatives.

The Mayor also provided some insights into the Pipers River Transfer Station Fee Increase. The fee increase has occurred due to changes to waste management strategies at a Federal and State level. He provided an assurance that there is no intention to close the Pipers River Transfer Station, however some upgrading will be required. Although the recent fee rises will be unpalatable to most Weymouth residents, the rationale he provided at least provides a logical explanation.
