Generator

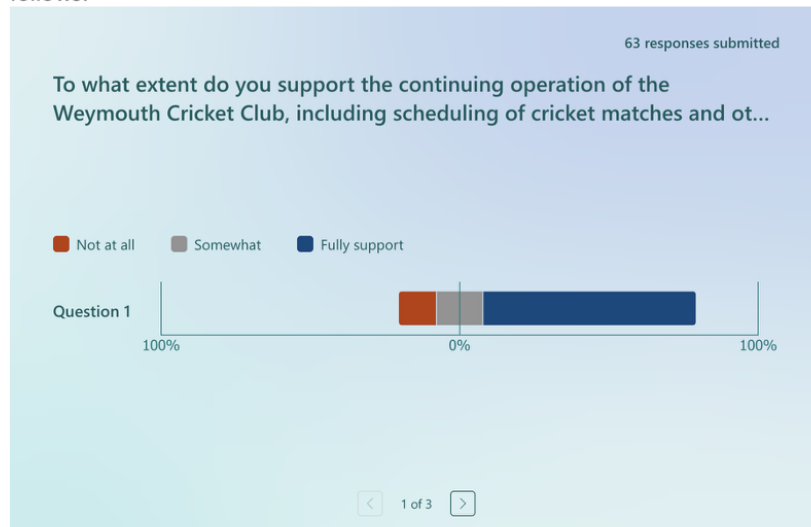
