Commonwealth Grant



Approximately 30 residents attended the latest George Town Council Roadshow on Saturday, May 18.


Attendees heard presentations by Greg Kieser, Shane Power, Rick Dunn, Cheryl Hyde and Snr. Sgt. John King from Tas Police
