- **Pre-16 provision:** Tuesday–Wednesday –Thursday, with flexible attendance options.
- **Post-16 provision:** Monday and Friday through our Flexzee Re-engagement Programme. 2 days per week.
- **Holistic, person-led curriculum** focusing on SEMH, confidence, wellbeing and personal development.
- **Gradual exposure to education**, new experiences and opportunities, building confidence at a pace that feels right for each learner.
- **Individualised support and external partnerships**, tailored around the needs, interests and aspirations of each learner.
- **Attendance and re-engagement support**, working collaboratively with schools, families, alternative provisions and local authorities.

Flexzee is our bespoke re-engagement programme

Flexzee is a learner-led re-engagement programme supporting individuals to rebuild confidence and reconnect with education.

Through personalised support and hidden learning, it helps learners progress into positive next steps, including education, employment, or training.

2 days per week - 12 Week commitment.

VTCT Level 1 Award, Certificate & Diploma in Vocational Studies Hair & Beauty

A flexible qualification pathway designed to meet learners where they are in their re-engagement journey, with different entry points throughout the year.

- Award — 80 GLH
- Certificate — 115 GLH
- Diploma — 305 GLH

Learners' starting points will differ depending on their attendance, engagement and time available. Their pathway will be discussed and assessed collaboratively with the learner and all services involved, ensuring they can work towards a recognised qualification without being held back.

The programme combines hair, beauty and makeup with personal development, employability, work experience, community action and next-step planning. Learners gain practical experience across the wider hair and beauty sector, helping them build confidence, discover their strengths and make informed decisions about their future. The end goal is to achieve an accredited qualification within the hair and beauty industry, while gaining a broad understanding and experience across the sector to support a well-informed choice about their next steps.

Our approach is simple: we see each person as they are and tailor our support around them.

We create a broad, balanced and personalised curriculum based on each learner's starting point, interests, strengths and goals.
