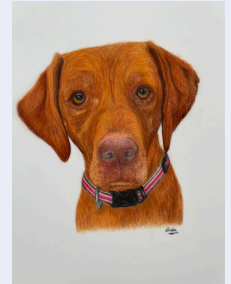


It's time for Frothy Coffee Friday

Breaking News

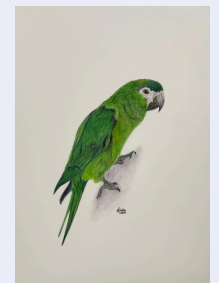

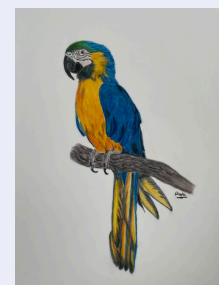
