

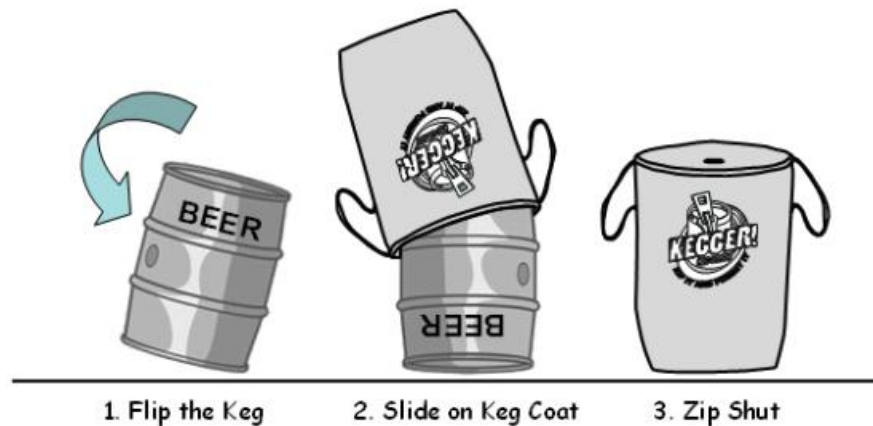
Thank you for purchasing KegCoat. This is a fun passion project of mine and hope you enjoy the product as much as I do! Below are the instructions to keep your KegCoat in great shape for years to come.

WARNING

Not following these instructions could damage your Keg Coat.

Do not attempt to lift your keg into the keg coat! Follow these instructions when putting a keg into your Keg Coat

1. Don't tap the keg yet! Flip the keg over on it's top
2. Slide the Keg Coat onto the keg, making sure it is all the way on. You may have to wiggle it on to squeeze out air between the liner and the insulation inside the Keg Coat.
3. Ensure that the bottom of the keg is firmly against the bottom of the Keg Coat.
4. Flip the keg right-side-up, and zip shut the Keg Coat.
5. Tap your Keg. **DON'T PUMP IT!** Pour the first few beers before pumping your tap. The keg is already pressurized, and over-pressurizing the keg will cause foamy beer.
6. Enjoy!
