A HOUSE RESOLUTION URGING CONGRESS TO SUPPORT THE NATION OF ISRAEL IN RESPONSE TO THE UNPROVOKED ATTACKS.

Whereas, on October 7, 2023, the terrorist organization Hamas launched an unprovoked attack on Israeli civilians; and

Whereas, innocent men, women, and children have been captured and killed by Hamas terrorists; and

Whereas, Israel declared war against Hamas on Sunday, October 8, 2023; and

Whereas, Israel and the United States of America are close friends and allies thanks to the 75-year partnership between our two countries, built on mutual interests and shared democratic values; Now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:

SECTION 1. The United States Congress is urged to offer full and unequivocal support of Israel financially and otherwise for as long as it takes for Israel to bring justice in light of the unprovoked attacks on innocent Israeli civilians.

SECTION 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.

Rep. Paré Slams NC House Democrats for Walking Off Floor During Vote in Support of Israel

Raleigh, NC — Twelve North Carolina Democrats <u>walked off</u> the House floor yesterday in opposition to a <u>bipartisan resolution</u> supporting Israel and condemning the heinous attacks by Hamas. In response, Rep. Erin Paré (R-Wake), who is a primary sponsor of the resolution, slammed the Democrats for their refusal to stand up for America's closest ally in the face of such evil.

"It is unconscionable to me that Democrats have become so extreme that they walked out and refused to vote on a resolution condemning the slaughtering of children and raping of women," said Rep. Paré. "Their shameful actions have sent a terrible message to not only the people of Israel, but all of America's allies across the world.

"When I spoke on the floor, I expressed my strong hope that we could come together as a body to support Israel and stand up against the evil and heinous actions of Hamas. Sadly, these twelve Democrats chose to turn their back and walk out in shame. While they chose to side with terrorists who murdered innocent babies, the people of North Carolina will always stand with Israel and against terrorism."


