Bed Bug Treatment Preparation Sheet

To properly prepare your home for treatment of bed bugs, use the following guidelines to help assure control:

1. **Reduce clutter** (i.e., throw out shoeboxes, papers, etc.)
2. All books / magazines / papers / or any paper products need to be **inspected**. If there are signs of infestation, they must be either discarded or heat treated.
3. **Remove** all items from under bed.
4. **Go through** all items within 10 feet of bed. After inspection, if no infestation is found, bag uncontaminated items and seal bag.
5. **Vacuum** floors
6. **Remove** any pet food that is out in the open.
7. **Remove/Inspect** sheets, linens, and clothing from dresser drawers.
8. **Remove** all curtains from windows.
9. **Place** linens / curtains / bed sheets / clothing in plastic bags.
10. **Bag as many items as possible in heavy duty trash bags**. Make sure to seal them by folding the top and using a rubber band and/or tie.
11. Purchase **vinyl covers** for mattress AND box spring (optional).
12. **Cover** mattress and zip completely shut making sure there are no openings. (this procedure should be done right after treatment – may be done by technician upon request).
13. If couch or other upholstered items are contaminated and unsalvageable, they **CANNOT BE TREATED**. They must be thrown away. Wrap items in plastic prior to moving and mark with spray paint to discourage others from taking back into building.
14. **Inform** pest control operator of any health issues, such as pregnancy/asthma/reduced lung capacity, etc.
15. **Everyone MUST vacate the premises for 4 hours after treatment, pets included.**
16. Upon return, **do not** touch treated areas until dry.
17. **Do not** self-treat with foggers or over the counter products – including Raid.
18. **Wash** all sheets, linens, clothes, etc. in **HOT WATER** and DRY on **HIGH HEAT**.

19. **Place** all the clean items in new plastic bags. Please do not open these bags until after treatment, or until bedbugs are not present.

Proper preparation is essential for best results!
