SPIDER PREPARATION SHEET



Occasionally indoor silverfish / spider treatment is necessary. Normally treated areas are where spiders / silverfish roam. These areas can include baseboards, ceiling corners, and around window and door frames. Possible dusting of the attic and / or subareas. Proper preparation is important to achieve the best possible results.

- Pick up all loose items from the floor: shoes, books, magazines, clothes, etc.
- If possible, move furniture away from walls
- Vacuum well in corners and behind furniture to remove accumulated dust and debris.
- Kitchen: put away all food, including fruit, butter dishes, salt and pepper shakers, and so on. (put them in cabinets or drawers)

- Bathrooms: place toothbrushes, soaps, and toiletries in drawers or cabinets
- Closets - If you want the closets to be treated, remove items from the floor and shelves (hanging clothes may remain)
- Be prepared to leave the house for 2 1/2 hours for drying time.
- After the home has been treated, wait 10-14 days to see results. Expect 80% control. A spider can be seen before it dies, and an occasional spider is normal.
