Coming out of COVID and with an unstable economy our donors stepped up and we couldn't be happier with what Brax and TB1F were able to accomplish this year. After an incredible first two years, we set the bar high for Year 3 with a goal of \$250K and we are happy to say we crushed that number, surpassing \$558K. Incredible!!





