FAQ

How does the settling-in process work?

At Little Panda's Clubhouse, we pride ourselves in understanding the importance of every child having a really good settling-in period. We understand how difficult this process can be, for both the child, and for the parents. At Little Panda's Clubhouse we recommend you:

1. Talk

Chat with your child about where different people go during the day, and why.

Talk to your child about the fact that one day they will go to child care, and the fun activities they will see and do there.

2. Read

Read stories about children starting child care.

Some excellent examples are:

Yoyo Goes to Play Groups by Jeanette Rowe,

Adam's Daycare by Julie Ovenell-Carter.

3. <u>Visit</u>

Start visiting child care centers a few weeks or even months, before your child starts care.

These visits may help your child get use to the environment, and show him/her how much fun it would be at child care.

4. Use Transition Objects

Taking an object from home may help your child to feel safe and secure. Example (stuffed animal, favorite blanket)

5. Give Some Control To Your Child

Giving your child some control over their day can help him/her feel more accepting of the things that they can't control.

Example: In the morning allow your child to pick his/her own clothes "from a selection of child care friendly options or "select a fruit that he/she would like to take for the drive".

6. Walk Away! Don't Look Back!

It can be so tempting for parents to drag out the farewell, to have one last hug, kiss, or to pop back in to sneak a peek to see how their child is settling in. Just. Walk. Away.

It is so hard to do..... I KNOW! However it is much more helpful to your child to have a warm and loving goodbye that is just that - a goodbye.

Dragging it out just makes the separation longer and more painful.



How will I know what my child has been up to at Little Panda's Clubhouse?

A Children's Daily Log can be provided "per your request" (we may also customize one just for you)

These sheets may include:

- What your child has eaten and how much.
- When your child had a nap and for how long.
- All of your child's diaper changes.
- The activities they have taken part in and what they enjoyed the most.
- How settled they have been during the day.
- Any additional messages.

How do I pay my childcare fees?

We ask that payments are made on Friday by 5:00 PM. We are able to make arrangements for customers to pay weekly should you wish to do so but this will need to be agreed upon at the time of registration.

Payments can be made in Venmo, cash, check or money orders. We do not accept card payments.


Please Remember:

- Please label all items with child's first and last name.
- All creams and sunscreens to be applied require a completed medical authorization form and must be kept in their original containers with your child's full name on it.
- All prescriptions must be in the original containers with the patient's name, dosage and prescribed time to be given. The doctor must complete a medical form before medication can be administered.
- Any over the counter medications (Tylenol, Motrin, etc.) require a
 permission form from your doctor which must include the proper dosage
 for your child's weight, age and the reason why it is to be administered.
