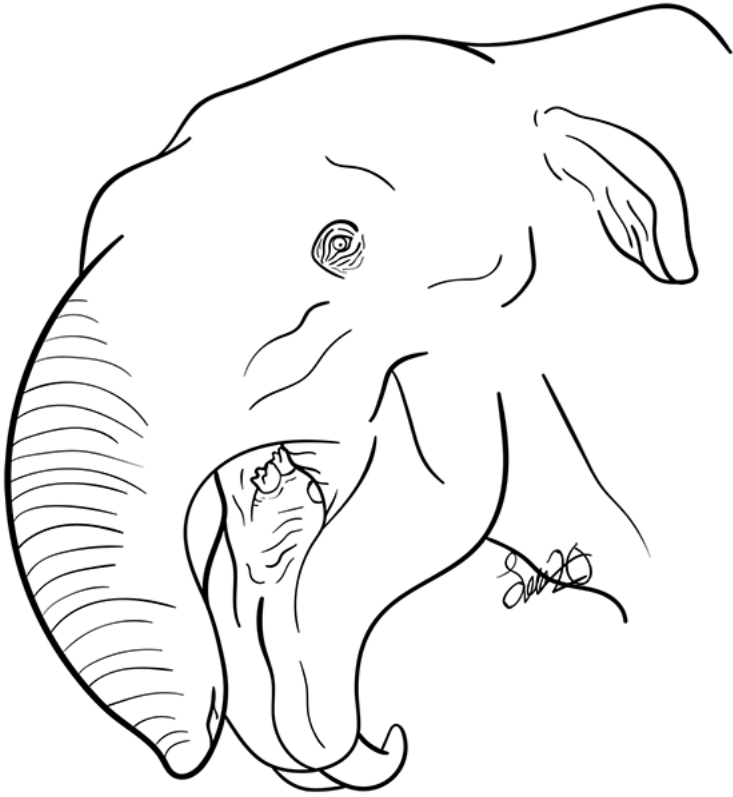


Figure 1. *Deinotherium giganteum*

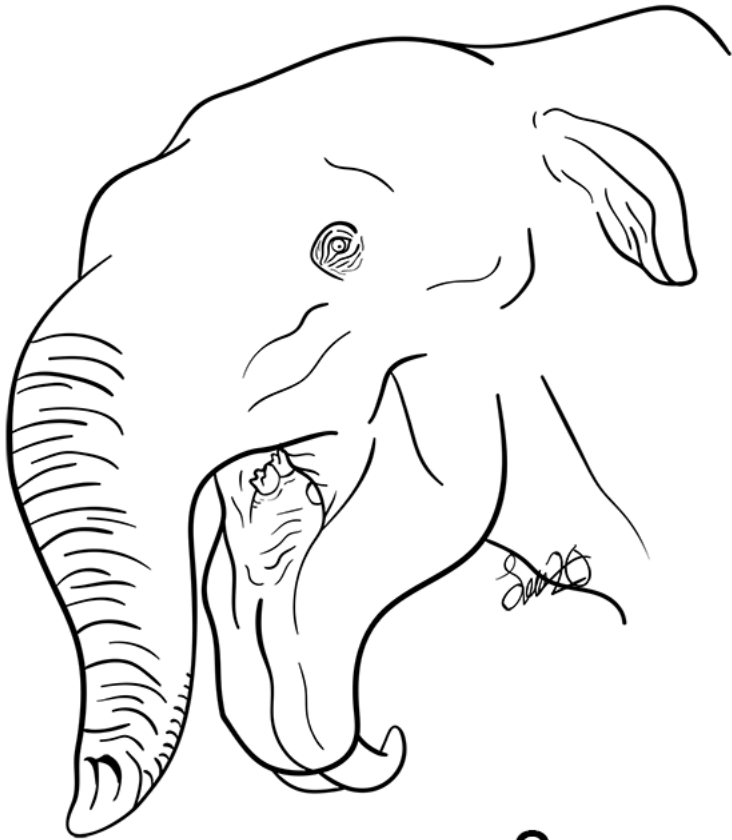

Figure 2. *Deinotherium giganteum*

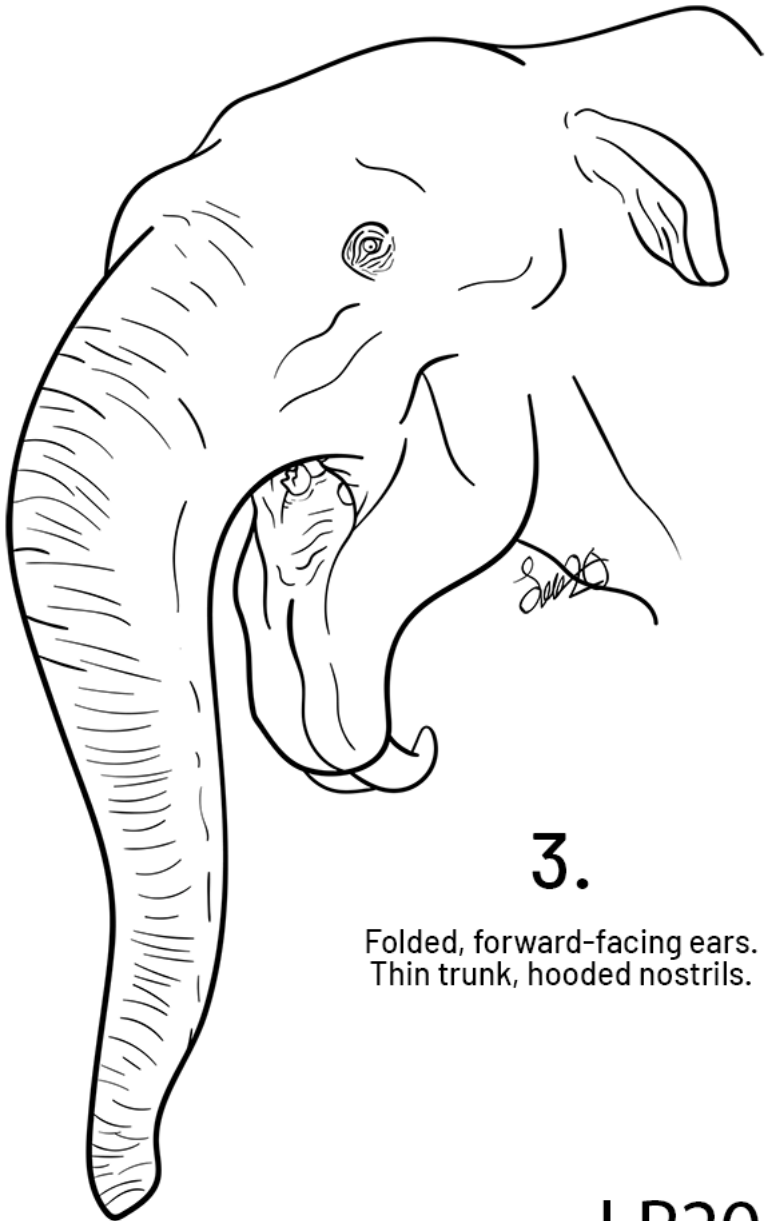

Figure 3. *Deinotherium giganteum*

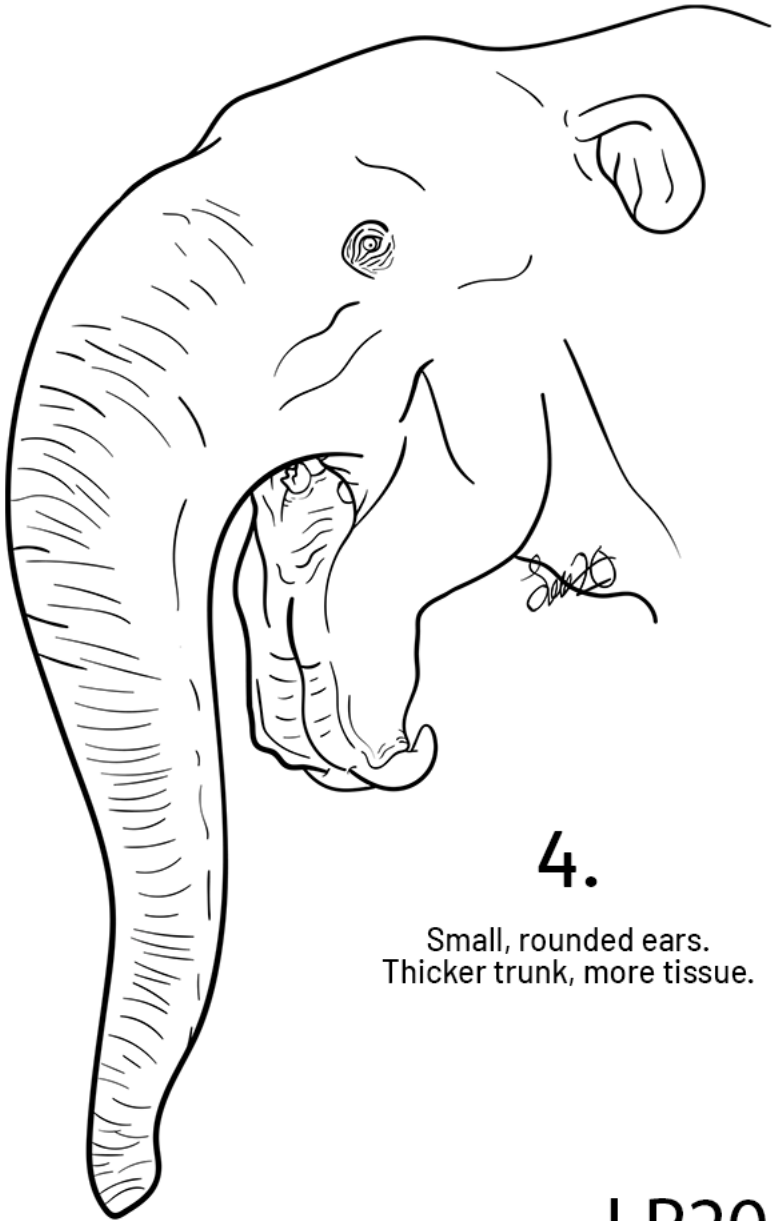

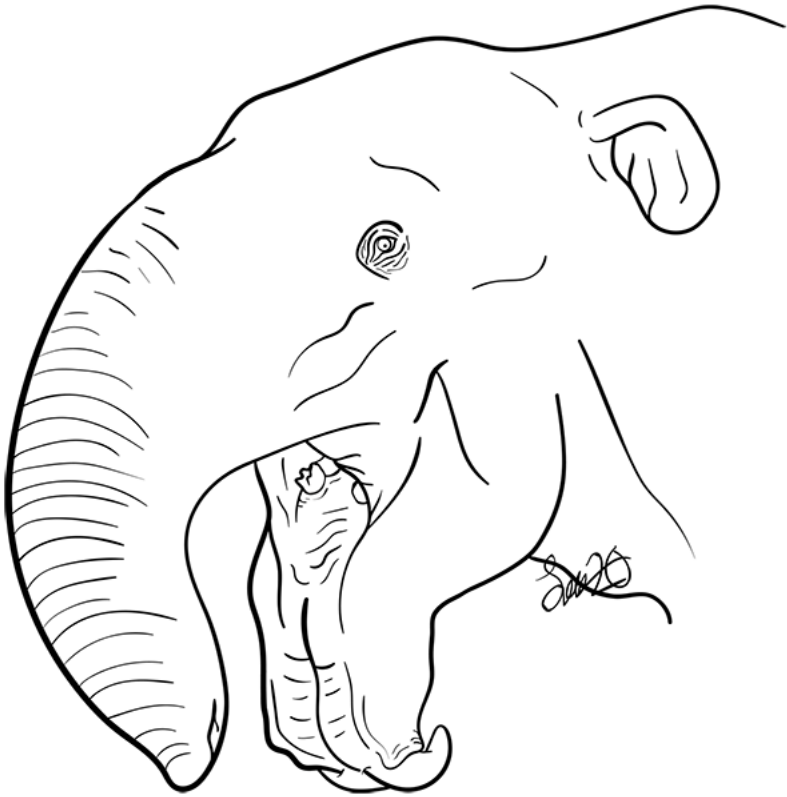

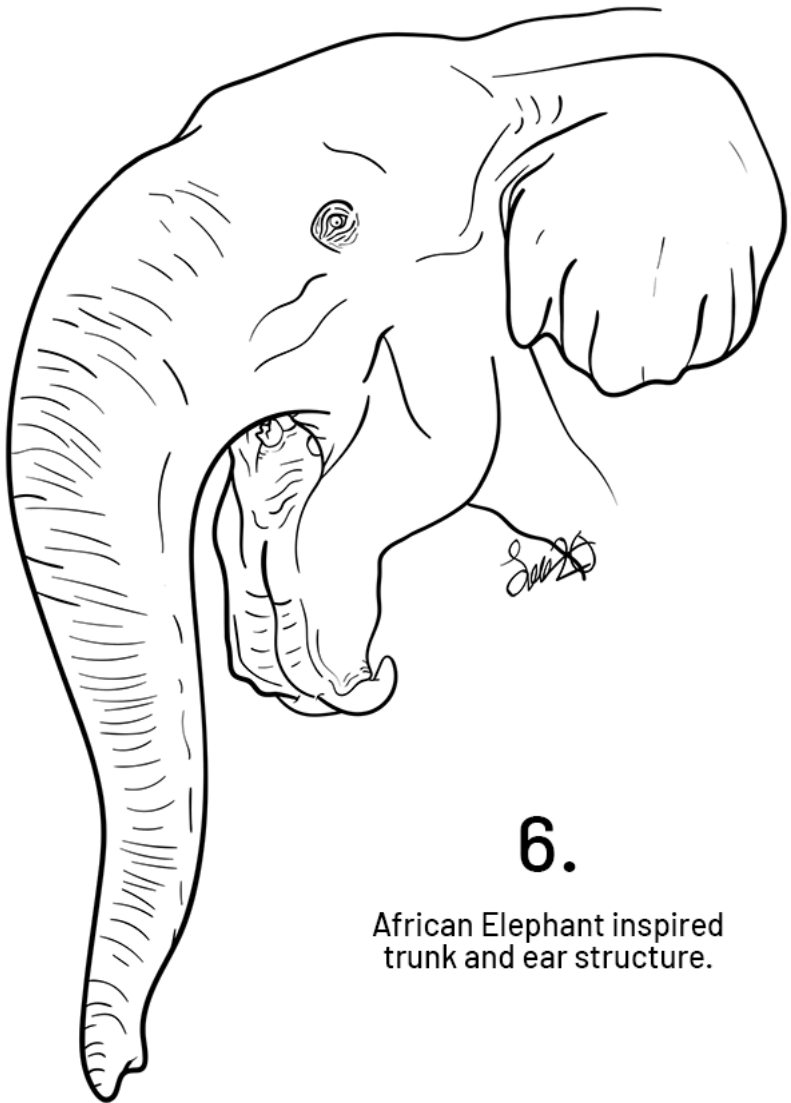
Figure 5. *Deinotherium giganteum*

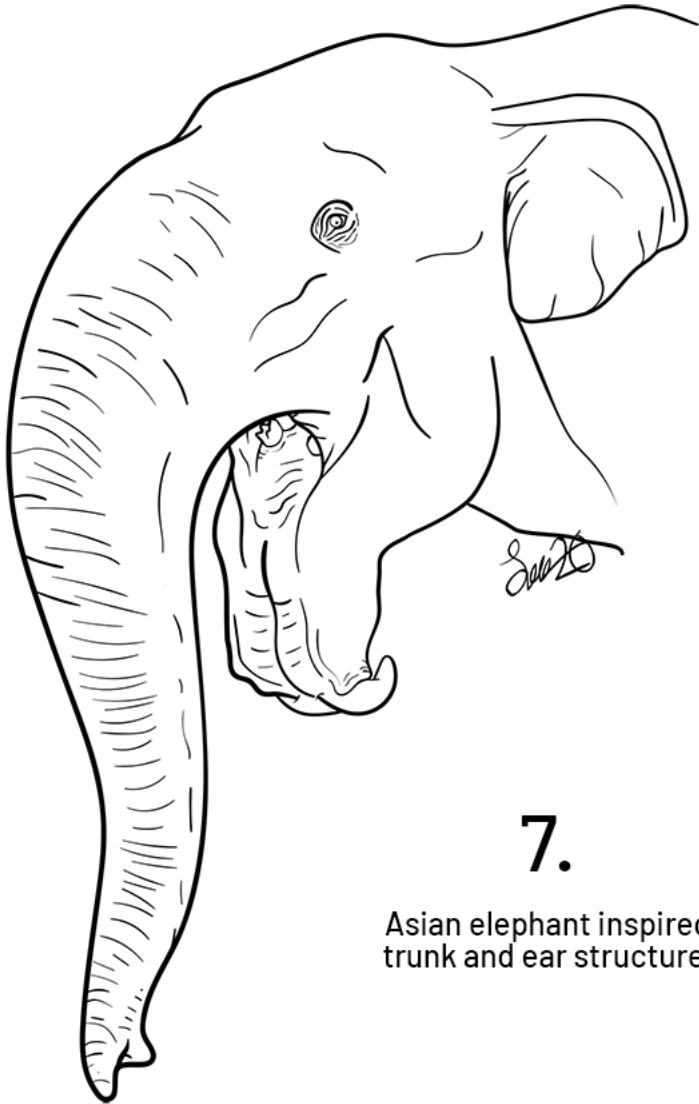

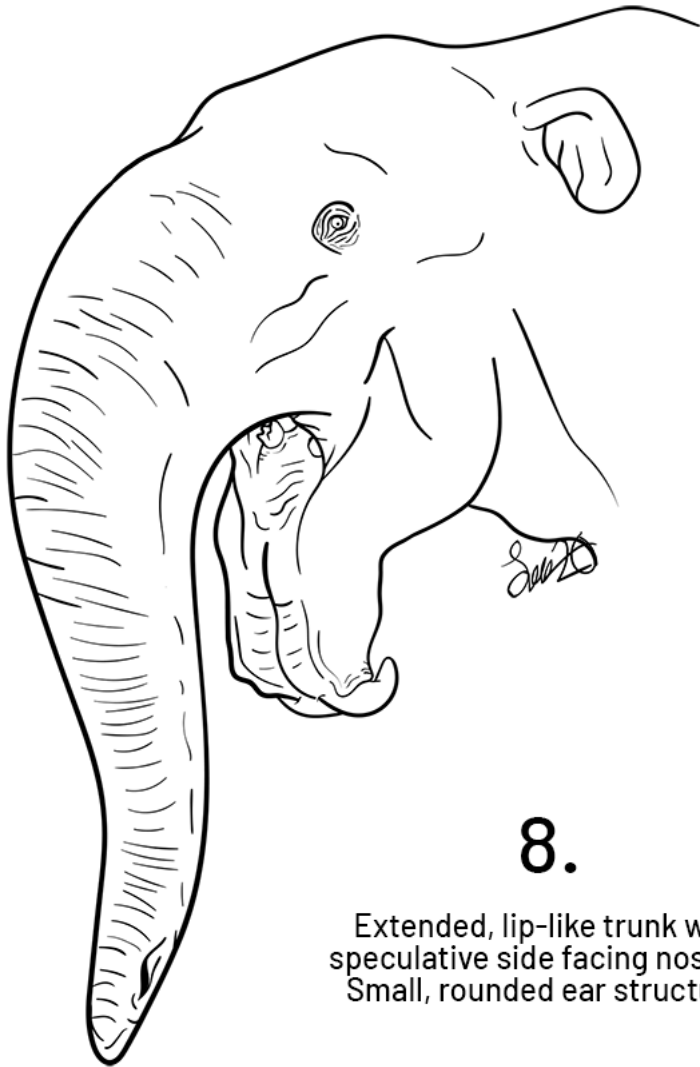

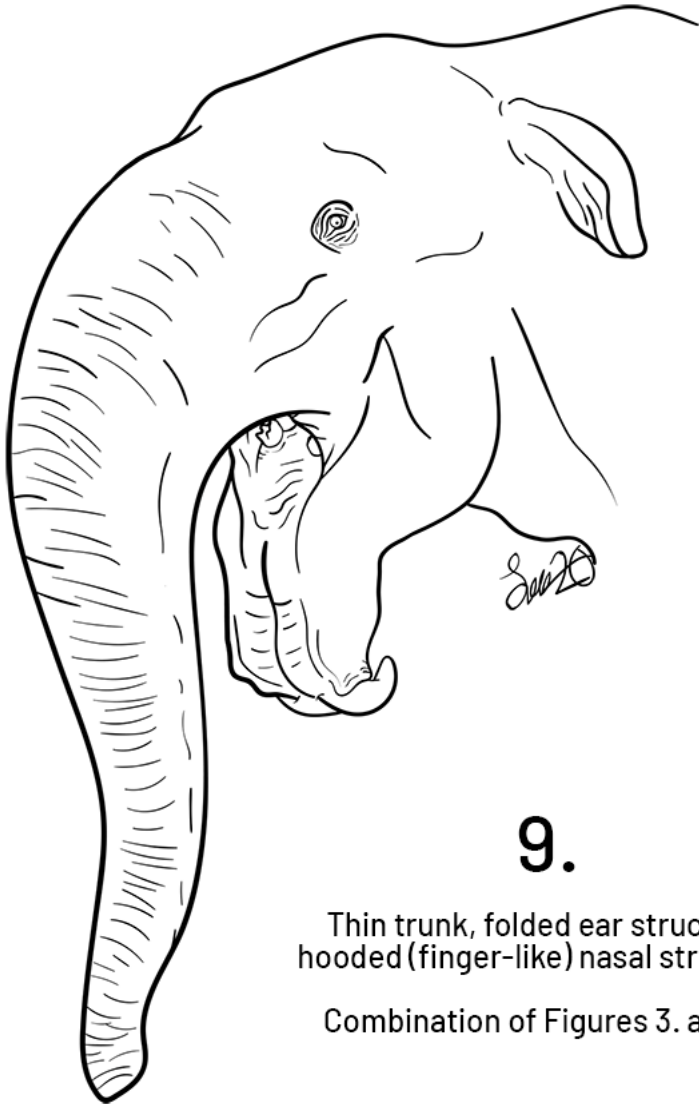
Figure 8. *Deinotherium giganteum*

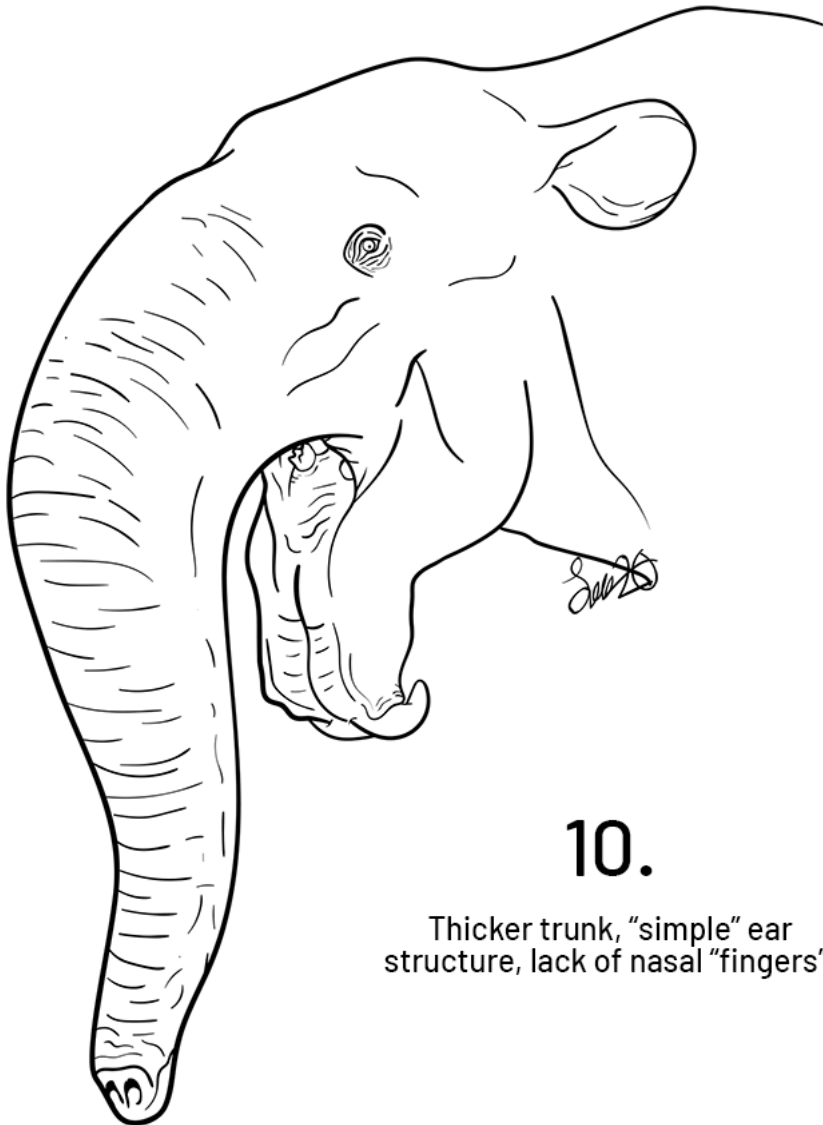
