Entry Fee: \$15.00 per class or \$40.00 per horse/pony all eligible classes
Entries-All entries to be received by the day prior to the show-Thursday May 25 by 8.30 pm.

Entries received after that time will incur a late fee of \$10. Entries will be accepted on the day prior to 8.90am.

Conditions of Entry

- Must be a current financial GCEC member or EA member if the show is official.
- Must uphold the GCEC Code of Conduct.
- Riders must wear a current approved safety helmet and riding boots at all times whilst mounted on their horse or pony.
- The Judge's decision is final in all cases. Judges are not to be approached by any competitor or spectator.
- The organisers/committee of the Geraldton Combined Equestrian Club reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any events they deem necessary on the day.
- The Geraldton Combined Equestrian Club reserves the right to interpret all rules and make a decision where any dispute arises in the best interests of its members.
- All dogs must be on a leash.
- All horses are expected to have an official height certificate if competing in height classes. (If there are circumstances whereby this has not been able to occur, please email us prior to entry)
- Horses and/or Ponies are not eligible to compete in more than one breed class unless dual registered.
- Multiple registered horses may compete in all eligible classes either ridden or led.
- Horses/ponies entering Best Led Youngstock MUST compete in a pre-nominated led breed class to be eligible to enter.
- Classes 37, 38 and 62 are only for horses who do not have a representative breed class listed
- When competing in Led classes, all handlers must be GCEC members and please ensure that the handler is wearing appropriate shoes for running as they will be required to run the horse out for the judge
- Proof of horse registration is required upon submission of entries
- You do not have to be a current financial member of the relevant breed society
- Screenshot/photocopy of Thoroughbred/Standardbred Studbook sufficient for entry.
- Classes will be made available on the day if there are three or more horses/ponies of a breed not listed in the program
- Protests must be made in writing to the organising committee together with a fee of \$50.00 within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the class. Fee will be forfeited if protest is dismissed.
- All handlers/riders of stallions and lead rein handler to be over 18yr
- Lead Rein riders to be 5-8yrs
- Small Show Pony 12hh and under rider must be 14 years and under
