

Harold Stander Scholarship - 2018 Tanner Lee Wiedmeyer

Tanner is a senior at Saline High School and participated in soccer, bowling, Students Against Drunk Driving (SADD) and the Connecting Club where he volunteered his time outside of school hours to mentor peers who have social challenges. He has assisted special needs children with their Christmas shopping for their families.

He was co-captain of his high school bowling team for the past two years and participated in its fundraising efforts. Tanner posted his high series of 737 in the 2017 Arbor Valley Youth Annual Tournament at Lodge Lanes and that series propelled him and his doubles partner Drake Jones to the Boy's Doubles title with a 1649 handicap score (1447 actual). He also won the Boy's Division A Handicap all-events title with a 2346 handicap score. His personal best high game is 288.

Tanner participates in Michigan Junior Majors Association (MJMA) tournaments and Junior Gold tournaments. He has qualified to advance to the Junior Gold tournament in Dallas, Texas.

He plans on attending Adrian College and study elementary education with an eye toward a masters degree in special education.
