

**ARBOR VALLEY USBC ASSOCIATION
ALL ASSOCIATION TEAM CRITERIA - MEN
(Beginning with the 2020-2021 season)**

Points will be awarded in the following manner:

Points will be given in the following tournaments on the basis of the top ten finishers. 15 for first, 12 for second, 10 for third, 8 for fourth, 6 for fifth, then 5-4-3-2-1. All finishes are based on actual pinfall only.

Association Annual Open (current season) tournament doubles, singles and all events.

Michigan State Open (previous season) tournament doubles, singles and all events. This is the top ten finishers from the Arbor Valley USBC Association but must be in the top 100 places of the tournament. First, second or third overall in the tournament would receive bonus points of 10, 8, or 5 respectively.

USBC Annual Open Championship (previous season) tournament doubles, singles and all events. This is the top ten finishers from the AVUSBC but must be in the top 100 places of the tournament. The same bonus formula as the state tournament applies in the cases of first, second or third overall in the tournament.

USBC Masters (current season) top ten overall only using the same formula as above.

For each honor score game points will be as follows:
300 = 5 points with a maximum of 20 points that can be earned.

For each honor score series points will be as follows:
826 and up = 5 points, 800-825 = 4 points with a maximum of 20 points that can be earned.

An individual will also receive points for their highest AVUSBC Yearbook average of 48 games or more as follows: 240 & Up = 20 points, 230-239 = 16 points, 220-229 = 12 points, 210-219 = 8 points, 200-209 = 4 points.
