 - 342 Calls in November, Slowest month of 2025 thus far.
 - Received quote for station renovation \$188,200.00. We have \$97,000.00 in Grant account. Chief will reach out to Matzie's Office to see if we can get another grant.
 - Beaver County Fire Fighter's Association putting together an advisory committee of 12-15 people in fire, Ems, 911 to oversee curriculum protective services at the BC Vocational School for 10th, 11th, 12th grades. Chief Priolo and Corporal Jones were asked to join.

- Baden Payment Issue
 - Mr. Mitchell (BVRPD Solicitor) spoke to Michael Stuben from Baden Borough Council and the Baden Solicitor about the Pension issue. Baden asked why the police were not paying their own MMO. Mr. Mitchell explained the state aid went to Baden and Conway instead of the Regional, which is why the towns paid the state aid for the MMO, and the Regional paid the rest owed. The AG approved the state aid going to the Boroughs because the Regional would not have received any. Budget was approved at the end of 2024 by all four municipalities for the Regional to pay \$ 302,205.00. Mr. Mitchell stated that in his opinion Baden overpaid by the \$12,921.00 that they sent in on top of the state aid they received. Conway also sent in the state aid they received.
 - Going forward this will not be an issue anymore we are to the point where the state aid will come in and is on the income side of 2026 budget.
