## SPEEDING AND SAFETY

Thank you.

If anyone notes abuses please jot down the vehicle's license plate or address and we can try to approach the concerned party in the hopes of preventing an injury or death. The Board has no power to issue legal warnings or tickets. For this, please notify the police (general non-emergent number 703-691-2131 or our Springfield station 703-644-7377) who can attempt to document someone at the time of a violation.

Regarding the children, parents thank you for monitoring and instructing your young ones to move out of the way. My personal experience is they have been very responsive and responsible.
