
Trial #2: Will begin approximately 30 minutes after the end of

DIRECTIONS, SET UP, AND PARKING: <u>From North or South:</u> Take CA 99 to Madera. Exit on Cleveland Avenue and go west. Just past Panda Express and the Grocery Outlet, turn left on Schnoor Avenue. Continue past the first stop sign. With Lowe's on your right, turn left into the Fairgrounds. You may park and set up easy ups on the north, south, and west sides of the ring. RVs with hookups will be assigned to set up by the trees on the east side of the ring. RVs without hookups and tent campers may set up on the north side of the entry road.

Rally and Obedience have <u>separate entry forms</u> which are included in this premium for your convenience. Incorrect or missing information (including signature) will invalidate entries. <u>Please use one entry form per dog.</u>

PLEASE SEND RALLY AND OBEDIENCE ENTRIES TO DEBBIE CRUSENBERRY. DO NOT SEND THEM TO THE PERSON TAKING CONFORMATION ENTRIES.

RALLY CLASSES OFFERED: Masters C/B/A, Excellent C/B/A, Advanced C/B/A, Novice C/B/A

OBEDIENCE CLASSES OFFERED: Utility B/A, Open ODX B/A, Open CDX B/A, Novice C/B/A, and Beginner Novice B/A.

Group Sits and Downs to follow individual levels of classes. A, B, and C groups may be combined.

WILDCARD CLASSES OFFERED: Wildcard classes will be offered for all regular Obedience classes. Dogs can enter any Wildcard class without having to complete lower level ASCA titles. For example, an AKC Utility dog with no ASCA titles doesn't have to enter the Novice class. The dog can enter the Wildcard class in Utility to practice any exercises desired. For more information on Wildcard classes, refer to section 12.5, page 61 of the ASCA Obedience Rule book.

AWARDS: Rally: Ribbons for 1st – 4th, X ribbons for scores of 195 or over; Q ribbons for scores of 170-194. Rosettes for High Combined, High in Trial, and High in Trial Junior, as well as High Score Aussie and High Score Other Breed (entries with QT numbers).

Obedience: Ribbons for 1st - 4th and qualifying scores. Rosettes for High Combined, High in Trial, and High in Trial Junior as well as High Score Aussie and High Score Other Breed (dogs with QT numbers).

Additional Information:

- 1. Entry must be on current entry forms which are included with this premium or can be found on the ASCA website Obedience forms (https://www.asca.org/wpcontent/uploads/2016/04/obedentryform.pdf) Rally forms (https://wwwasca.org/wpcontent/uploads/2016/04/rallyentryform.pdf).
- 2. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Obedience and/or Rally program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- 3. Bitches in season are not allowed to compete.
- 4. No entry fees will be refunded after the close of pre-entries. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There is a \$35 service charge for returned checks.
- 5. These trials will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA.
- 6. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG.
- 7. These ASCA Rally and Obedience trials are open to all breeds, including mixed breeds, with an ASCA Registration or ASCA QTracking number. We will have forms available at the trial (so we can forward them to the ASCA office) but we encourage you to apply for a QTracking number in advance.
