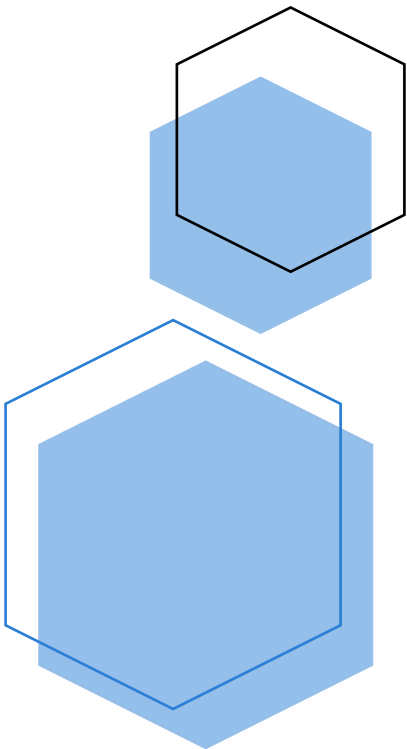


A PERFECT BLEND OF EGYPTIAN HERITAGE AND MODERN DESIGN

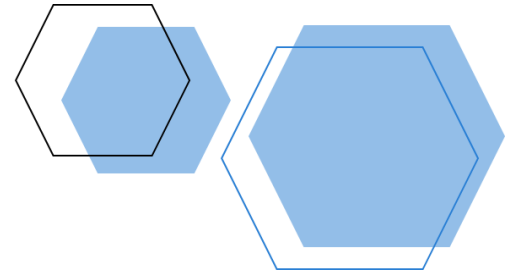

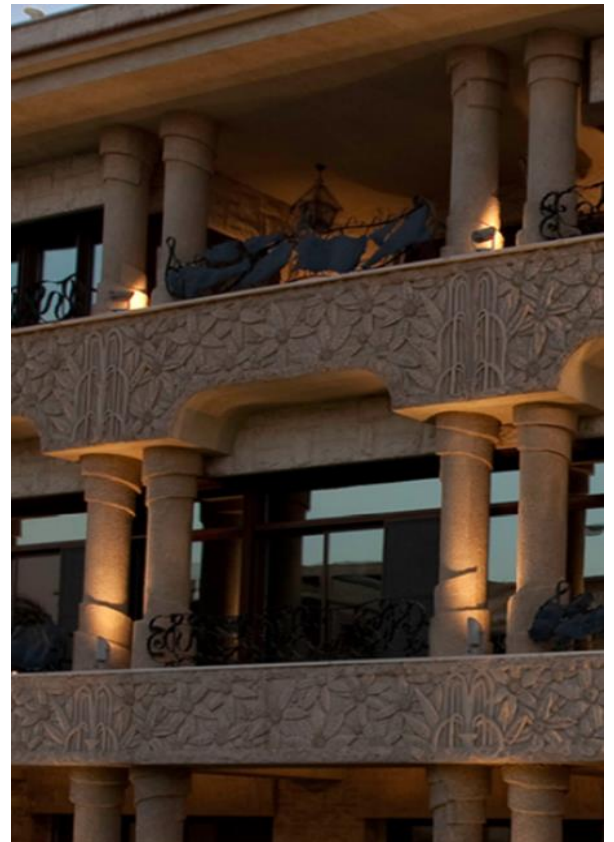

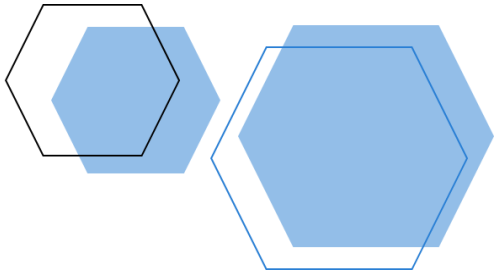
THE FACADE



The exterior of the building is just as impressive as the interior, featuring a facade that is inspired by the iconic La Pedrera by Gaudi. The architect used natural limestone mixed with wrought iron hardware and details, which are intricately designed in unique and seamlessly integrated floral and leaf shapes to create a textured and visually stunning exterior that is reminiscent of Gaudi's work. The wrought iron hardware and details, intricately shaped in floral and leaf patterns, are reminiscent of Art Nouveau, while the geometric shapes and clean lines are more typical of Art Deco. This fusion of styles adds to the overall modern and contemporary feel of the building while also paying homage to the rich history of Egyptian architecture.



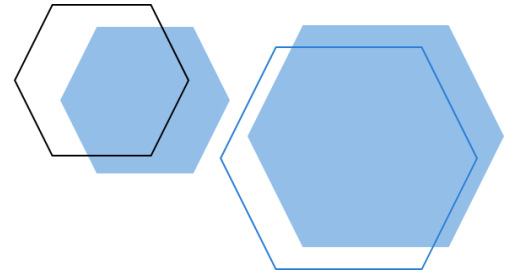
THE ENTRANCE



The main hall and stairs of the residence are a true masterpiece of Art Nouveau design. 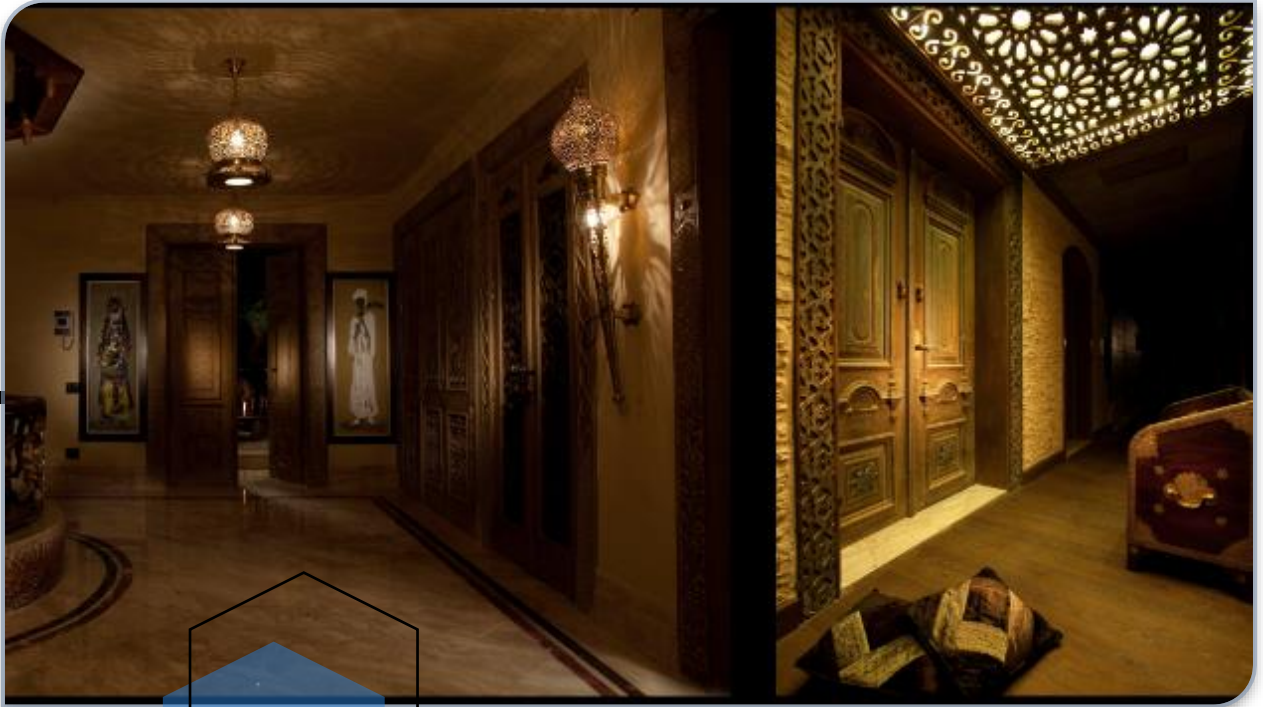
STAIRCASE



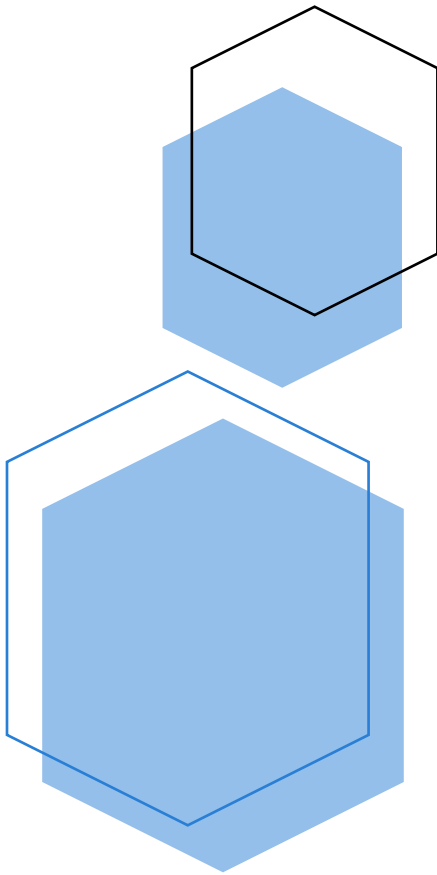

THE HERITAGE INFLUENCE



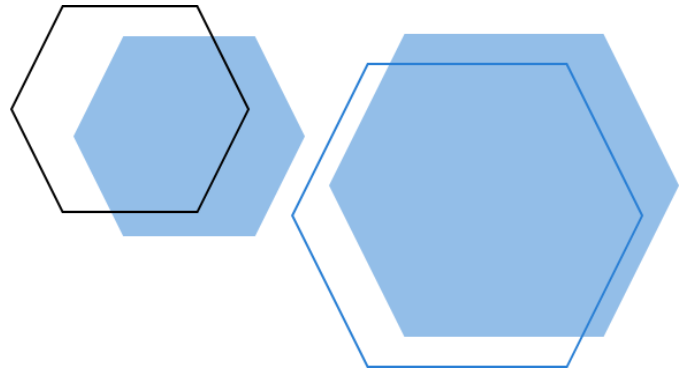

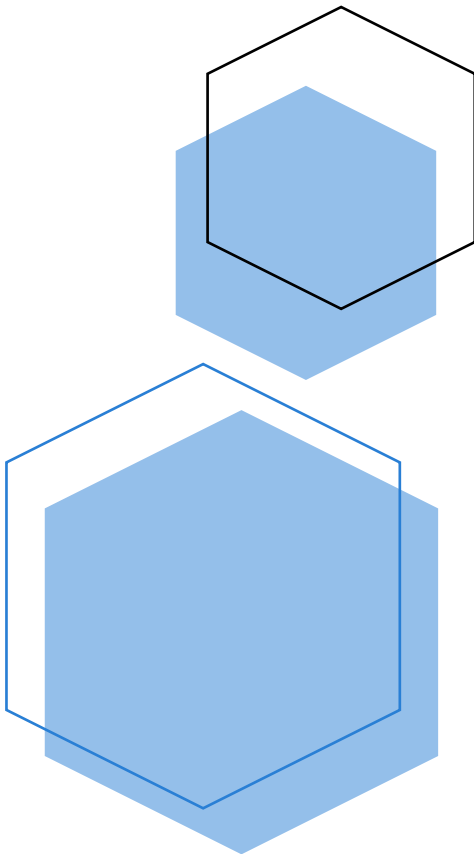
THE ENGLISH STYLE

MODERN TOUCHES



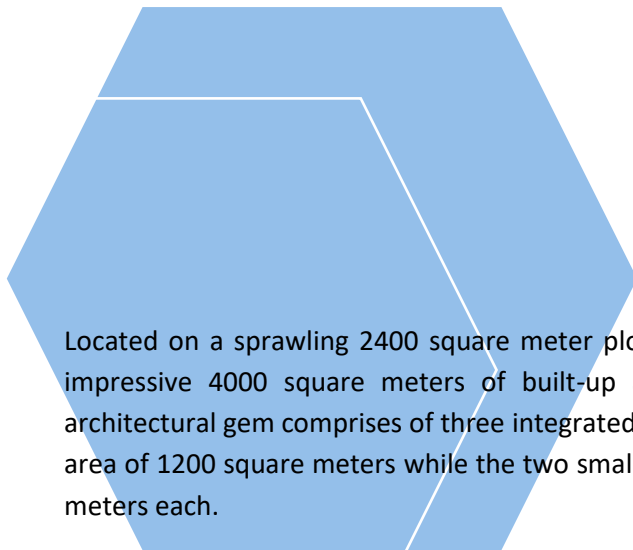

The modern style of this property is the perfect complement to the historic and traditional elements, creating a harmonious and comfortable living space.

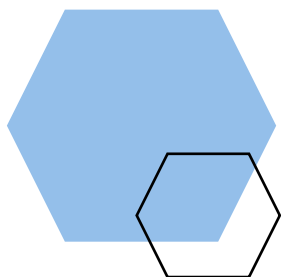
THE PROPERTY

FACTS



Located on a sprawling 2400 square meter plot, this luxurious property boasts an impressive 4000 square meters of built-up area spread over four floors. This architectural gem comprises of three integrated villas, the main villa with a generous area of 1200 square meters while the two smaller villas boast an area of 400 square meters each.

Boasting over 13 impeccably designed suites, the property exudes opulence and luxury at every turn. Each suite features its own private bathroom and dressing room, ranging in size up to 120 square meters. The property boasts 24 private and public bathrooms, catering to every need of its residents.



The property features an impressive seven kitchens, including a fully equipped main kitchen of 100 square meters with top-of-the-line appliances, pizza and bakery ovens, and more. Additionally, three food elevators are installed to deliver food directly to the three villas, ensuring a seamless dining experience. The property also boasts an outdoor kitchen in the garden with an area of about 40 square meters, complete with grills, shawarma stand, traditional ovens, and prepping areas. A dedicated kitchen for grilling is situated on the roof, covering an area of approximately 36 square meters. In addition, the property features a Chinese Teppanyaki kitchen for all culinary experiences.

The property offers ample parking facilities with an eight cars garage, while additional car parking is available outside the property. The garden, covering an area of about 1400 square meters, is the perfect retreat to relax and unwind. It features a large swimming pool with a distinctive design, outdoor living for up to 100 guests, and wonderful waterfalls, adding to the property's grandeur and charm.
