

2021 Kerr County SWCD Scholarship Program *Honoring Mr. Buck Menges*

Scholarship Amount – \$2,000

<u>Eligibility</u> – Kerr County SWCD will accept and consider scholarship applications from all students who reside in or attended school in Kerr County. Applicants may be a graduating high school senior or currently enrolled in a college or trade school. Applicants may be past winners of this scholarship who are still enrolled in a college or trade school pursuing a degree in an agriculture related field. Applicants must be of good character as evidenced by at least two letters of recommendation. Applicants must demonstrate a coherent degree plan and willingness to pursue a course of higher learning.

<u>Program Guidelines</u> – The Board of Directors of Kerr County Soil & Water Conservation District # 217 will choose the scholarship recipient. This scholarship will be granted to attend an accredited institution/trade school of higher education. Recipients must carry a minimum of 12 hours or be considered by the registrar to be a full-time student in the fall semester. The scholarship will be mailed directly to the Financial Aid Office of the selected school.

<u>Deadline</u> – Completed applications must be in the USDA Field Office by 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 31, 2021.
