Abutilon 'Estella's Little Bird': yellow flowers on this compact evergreen, to 1m height. May to October. £8.00

Abutilon 'Gerdmann's Red': red flowers on this compact evergreen form, to 1m height. May to October. £8.00

Abutilon 'Linda Vista Peach': soft orange flowers on this evergreen shrub. Sheltered position. £8.00

Acanthus dioscoridis ssp poerringii: smaller-growing species for sun, drought tolerant. June/July. 40cm. £8.00

Achillea coarctata: heads of yellow flowers, grey-green ferny leaves. Tolerant of dry conditions. June/July. 40cm. £7.00

Achillea 'Lucky Break': sulphur yellow flowers, grey green leaves. June/July. 30cm. £7.00

Achillea 'Moonshine': grey-green leaves with heads of yellow flowers. June/July. 40cm. £7.00

Achillea 'Red Velvet': clear red flowers, 60cm £7.00

Acis ionica: autumn snowflake from Albania & Ionian isles, best in a pot in alpine house or bulb frame. August/September. 10cm. £6.00

Aeschynanthus buxifolius KR 9978: neat evergreen foliage, red flowers in autumn on this shrublet for a sheltered position in part shade £7.00

Agapanthus 'Hole Park Blue': evergreen variety, the last to flower. August to October. 1m. £10

Agastache 'Fleur': coral flowers & nicely scented leaves. June to September. 40cm. £7.00

Agastache 'Golden Jubilee' blue flowers & golden leaves on this anise hyssop. June to September. 60cm. £7.00

Agastache 'Peachie Keen': soft orange flowers emerge from purple calyces. June to September. 40cm. £7.00

x *Alcalthaea* 'Parkrondell': hybrid mallow with pink flowers on a multistemmed plant. June to August. 1.2m £8.00

Allium hookeri 'Zorami': broad green leaves to 20cm with little greeny-white flower heads for a long time from August. Used as a vegetable in India. £7.00

Allium angulosum: grey-green strap leaves & mauve flower heads June to August. 20cm £7.00

Allium 'Medusa's Hair': later-flowering form of clumping allium. July to September. 20cm. £7.00

Allium 'Millennium': evergreen leaves with mauve flower heads, the best of the *angulosum* types. 20cm £7.00

Aloiampelos striatula: (formerly *Aloe striatula*) the hardiest aloe, yellow flowers in June. 1m. £12.00 (2 litre pots)

Alstroemeria 'Inca Pulse': red flowers from June. 40cm. £8 (available from April '24)

Althaea officinalis 'Romney Marsh': pale pink flowers from June. 2m. £7.00

Amsonia hubrichtii: pale blue flowers in early summer above stems with narrow leaves, very long-lived perennial. £8.00

Anisodonteia 'El Royo': very long-flowering shrubby mallow, rather more upright than shrubby *Lavatera*, pink cups with a darker eye. Especially good in autumn. To 2m. £8.00

Anthriscus sylvestris 'Going for Gold': golden-leaved cow parsley, foamy white flowers in May. Will self-sow. 80cm. £6.00

Anthriscus sylvestris 'Ravenswing' dark purple-leaved cow parsley, with foamy flowers in May. Again will self-sow. 76cm £6.00

Arisaema candidissimum: pink & white striped trumpets, this species is very late to emerge (even early summer). 60cm. £10.00

Arisaema taiwanense var. *cinereus*: very attractive species with silvered-foliage through the season, arum-type flowers in early summer. £10.00

Armeria 'Brutus': large growing form derived from *A. pseudarmeria*, white flowers from early summer. Very drought tolerant. 40cm. £7.00

Artemisia abrotanum: lad's love, cottage garden plant with feathery grey-green foliage. 70cm. £7.00

Artemisia arborescens: silver filigree foliage on this evergreen shrub. 70cm. £8.00

Artemisia canescens 'Alba': silver filigree foliage on this small shrub, 30cm. £7.00

Artemisia ludoviciana 'Valerie Finnis': silvery foliage, for a sunny & dry situation. 40cm. £7.00

Artemisia maritima filifera: silver filigree foliage on this low-growing perennial. 30cm. £7.00

Artemisia 'Nutans': finely cut silver foliage, low-growing perennial. 30cm. £7.00

Artemisia stelleriana 'Boughton Silver': low growing with divided silver leaves the main feature. £7.00

Artemisia valesiaca: silver filigree foliage on this low-growing perennial. 30cm. £7.00

Arum creticum Karpathos form: Mediterranean bulb, leaves emerge in autumn, trumpet-flowers in spring, summer dormant, this is the deepest yellow form of *Arum creticum*. For sun & well-drained soil, very drought tolerant. £8.00

Arum creticum 'Marmaris White': white form of *Arum creticum*, this is very unusual. Leaves present over winter, flowers in spring. £8.00

Aster amellus 'Forncett Flourish': violet flowers, more upright plant than 'King George'. August/September. 40cm. £7.00

Aster amellus 'King George': violet daisy flowers for a long time from August. Relaxed habit. No mildew. 40cm £7.00

Aster amellus 'Lady Hindlip': pink daisy flowers. August/September. 40cm. £7.00

Aster radula 'August Skies': lavender daisies from August, 40cm. £7.00

Begonia pedata 'Snow Splash': white-splashed leaves, not hardy. £7.00

Begonia 'Torsa': large leaves on this herbaceous variety, hardy with winter mulching. £8.00

Begonia 'Ballawley': evergreen leaves with good purple winter colour, magenta flowers in spring. £8.00

Begonia 'Clare Maxine': evergreen foliage, large textured green leaves. Magenta flowers in spring. £8.00

Begonia cordifolia: this is a particularly good form from the late Michael Wickenden, evergreen with large glossy leaves, pale flowers in early spring. Very drought tolerant. £8.00

Begonia 'Godfrey Owen': magenta flowers in spring, leaves deep red in winter. April/May. £8.00

Begonia 'Overture': magenta flowers over good red winter foliage, tolerant of dry shade. March to May. £8.00

Begonia 'Pugsley's Pink': magenta flowers in spring, very good red winter foliage, tolerant of dry shade. March to May. £8.00

Begonia 'XXL': ruffled pink flowers March to May over large slightly crumpled leaves. £8.00

Beschorneria septentrionalis 'Bob Brown': variegated form of this Mexian species, rosettes of leaves like a yucca. Eventually after 3 or 4 years, the red flower spike (to 2m) will emerge, plant is monocarpic but will leave offsets after the main rosette has died. £15.00

Bidens aurea 'Hannay's Lemon Drop': airy daisy, yellow flowers, each petal tipped white. A clumper, not a spreader. 1.6m £7.00

Bidens aurea White form: pale lemon flowers from July for a long time. 1.6m £7.00

Brachyglottis monroi: small evergreen shrub grey-green leaves with wavy edges, yellow daisy flowers. Tolerant of dry conditions. May/June. 40cm. £8.00

Brunnera 'Looking Glass': silvered leaves, blue flowers in spring, good in dry shade. £7.00

Buddleja x weyeriana 'Sungold': clear orange flowers, June to September. Sterile, so no seedlings. To 2.6m £8.00

Bupleurum fruticosum: evergreen shrub for sun & well-drained soil, heads of greenish yellow flowers are very attractive to pollinators, also very good as cut flowers. July/August. 1m. £8.00

Calceolaria x banksii: like 'Kentish Hero' but the flowers are a darker bronze colour, the plant slightly larger growing. £7.00

Calceolaria 'Kentish Hero': subshrub with burnt-orange flowers over a very long period, hardy in a sheltered spot. 40cm, £7.00

Campanula isophylla 'Alba': white flowers in late summer on this trailing species. Does not like winter wet. July to September. 20cm. £6.00

Campanula isophylla 'Pamela': blue flowers with deeper tips to the petals on this trailing form. July to September. 20cm. £6.00

Centaurea bella: pink thistle flowers in early summer, grey-green leaves. Drought-tolerant. May/June. 40cm. £7.00

Centaurea cineraria ssp cinerea: white ferny leaves, good in dry sunny situation, purple flowers less exciting. 40cm, £7.00

Centaurea 'Jordy': black-red flowers cornflowers, May/June. Will repeat if cut down straight after flowering. 30cm £7.00

Centaurea montana 'Elworthy Glacier': white cornflowers with blue-tipped petals, May/June. 30cm £7.00

Centaurea montana 'Joyce': purple flowers, greyed leaves. May/June. 30cm. £7.00

Centranthus lecoqii: pinkish flowers over greyed leaves. June/July. 40cm. £7.00

x Chitalpa tashkentensis: drought-tolerant shrub with narrow leaves, pink tubular flowers in summer. June/July. 2m. £12.00.

Chrysanthemum 'Bretforton Road': purple semi-double flowers. October/November. 60cm. £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Bright Eyes': early-flowering hardy pompom variety, yellow with a darker centre. September/October. 80cm. £7.00

Chrysanthemum burnt-orange flowered: late-flowering single variety with spoon shaped petals, yellow on upper surface, bronze on lower. October/November. 70cm. £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Chelsea Physic Garden': very late flowering, tall, bronze red semi-double. November. 1.2m. £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Cousin Joan': dark red single flowers, October/ November. 90cm £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Dixter Orange': the longest-flowering chrysanthemum I know: double orange flowers open at the end of June & continue to November. 46cm £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Duchess of Edinburgh': double reddish-brown flowers from early October. 80cm £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'E.H. Wilson': small pale beige flowers on dark stems, very elegant & pretty. October/November. 40cm. £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Elaine's Hardy White': single long-petalled flowers open salmon & then quickly fade to white. October. 60cm £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Emperor of China': silvery pink flowers very late in the season, foliage becomes red in late autumn. November/December. 90cm. £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Erntekrantz': pale yellow double flowers from early October. This is a wonderful luminous colour in low autumn light. 40cm £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Esther': low-growing, long-flowering with an early start, dusty pink flowers contrast with dark stems on this hardy variety. 40cm. £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Etna': shorter variety with deep-red petals tipped chrome yellow. October/November. 40cm. £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Herbstkuss': early-flowering & low-growing with purplish-red flowers from September onwards. 40cm. £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Killerton Tangerine': semi-double orange-brown flowers very late in the season (from early November). 76cm £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Mary Stoker': pale orange/yellow flowers, mid-season (October). 60cm. £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Old Norwell': heads of single flowers open reddish terracotta with a large yellow eye. October. 76cm £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Poesie': semi-double white flowers age pinkish. October. 70cm £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Ruby Mound': dark red double flowers on a neat mound. October. 40cm £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Rumpelstilzchen': semi-double rusty-red flowers from September, 40cm. £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Sweetheart Pink': double, soft-pale pink, very pretty, from September, 60cm. £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Tapestry Rose': semi-double pinkish flowers, relatively early flowering from September. 60cm. £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Venus': dark pink single flowers open from the end of October. 60cm £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Wendy Tench': semi-double red, early-flowering, low-growing. September/October. 30cm. £7.00

Chrysanthemum 'Will's Wonderful': clusters of small single flowers, each petal yellow with a terracotta tip. Rounded habit. Very late-flowering, from end of October. 40cm £7.00

Cistus x aguilarii: white flowering evergreen shrub. May/June. 2m. £10.00

Cistus 'Ann Baker': white flowers with maroon basal blotch. May/June. 70cm height x 1m width £10.00

Cistus x dansereau 'Jenkyn Place': compact evergreen shrub, very long-flowering, white flowers with a central blotch. 80cm. May to August, the longest-flowering *Cistus*. £10.00

Cistus 'Gordon Cooper': white flowers with blotches, narrow evergreen foliage. 1.2m. May/June. £10.00

Cistus ladanifer: white flowers with large basal maroon blotch; aromatic evergreen leaves. April to June. 1.6m. £10.00

Cistus ladanifer 'Pat': white flowers with large maroon basal blotches. £10.00

Cistus laurifolius: the hardiest species of *Cistus*, white flowers & evergreen leaves. May/June. 1m £10.00

Cistus monspeliensis 'Vicar's Mead': pale yellow flowers on this narrow-leaved evergreen shrub. May/June. 1m. £10.00

Cistus x picardianus: mauve-purple flowers on this grey-leaved shrub. May/June. 1.4m. £12.00

Cistus x pulverulentus 'Fiona': evergreen shrub, lavender purple flowers with a darker centre, grey-green foliage. May/June. 1m. £10.00

Cistus x pulverulentus 'Sunset': evergreen shrub, intense deep purple-pink flowers, grey-green foliage. May/June. 1m. £10.00

Cistus salviifolius: pure white flowers, grey-green leaves, this is quite a low-growing form. May/June. 60cm tall, but wide spreading. £10.00

Colchicum macrophyllum: beautiful tessellated pink & white flowers, the leaves are particularly fine on this, pleated like the leaves of *Veratrum*. 30cm. £10.00

Corydalis cheilanthifolia: yellow flowers over ferny foliage in early spring, for sun or part shade, will self-sow. 20cm. £6.00

Corydalis 'Craigton Blue': blue flowers, ferny foliage. For moist soil in shade. May-July. 40cm. £7.00

Corydalis vivipara: woodland species, summer dormant, ferny foliage through the winter, purple flowers in spring. 20cm. £6.00

Crassula coccinea: spectacular red flowers in early summer on this tender perennial. 20cm. £7.00

Crassula sarcocaulis: pink flowers for a long time, from July over succulent leaves. The plant forms a miniature tree. 30cm £6.00

Crinum 'Hannibal's Pink Abyssinicum', pale pink flowers in summer, similar to *Crinum moorei*. Divisions. £10.00

Crinum moorei hybrid from Glasgow: pale pink flowers in late summer, plant less massive than *Crinum x powellii*. 1m. £10.00

Crinum x powellii 'Krelagei': pale pink flowers, the backs of the petals with a dark reddish stripe. August/September. £10.00

Crocasmia 'Fugue': vigorous yellow/orange-flowered variety from Ballyrogan Nurseries £7.00

Crocasmia 'Regale': vigorous orange variety from Ballyrogan. July/August. 1m. £8.00

Crocoshia paniculata 'Cally Greyleaf': small orange-red flowers over fans of pleated grey leaves. July. 90cm £7.00

Crocoshia 'Toccata': vigorous yellow variety from Ballyrogan Nurseries. July/August. 1m. £8.00

Cuphea 'David Verity': long-flowering half-hardy perennial, tubular orange flowers with yellow tips. 50cm. £7.00

Cuphea 'Roxy': non-stop flowering on this half-hardy perennial, very attractive to bees. £7.00

Dahlia 'Magenta Star': dark-leaved, single flowers of strong pinkish-purple. July to October. 90cm. £7.00

Dahlia 'Twynning's Revel' dark-leaved, single flowers are a mixture of pink, yellow & orange. July to October. 90cm. £7.00

Delosperma 'John Proffitt': hardy South African succulent, mat-forming. Bright fuchsia daisy flowers are abundant from June to September. 6cm. £6.00

Dianthus barbatus 'Heart Attack': intense deep red flowers. 40cm. £7.00

Dianthus barbatus 'Monksilver Black': the darkest red-flowered sweet William. The flowers are set above dark red-purple foliage. May/ June. 40cm £7.00

Dianthus 'Chomley Farran': perpetual carnation, maroon flowers streaked with blue-grey. May/June/ 60cm. £7.00

Dianthus 'Fettes Mount': scented pink single flowers over narrow grey leaves, can repeat flower after the main flush in May/June. 30cm. £7.00

Dianthus 'Helena Allwood': heritage perpetual carnation, white flowers with red picotee. June to November. 70cm. £7.00

Dianthus 'Napoleon III': double dark crimson scented flowers from June. 16cm £6.00

Dianthus 'Passion': double red flowers on this garden carnation, from June. 20cm. £6.00

Diascia 'Blue Bonnet': blue-grey flowers for a long season. 20cm. £6.00

Diascia 'Coldham': long-flowering, lavender-pink spikes to 20cm. £6.00

Diascia 'Emma': long-flowering, dark salmon-pink flower spikes. 20cm. £6.00

Diascia personata: spikes of pink flowers over a long period. 60cm. £7.00

Diascia personata Orange Form: strong orange flowers all summer & later. 60cm. £6.00

Dicliptera sericea: firecracker plant, heads of orange flowers over grey-green foliage. Cold hardy, but does not like winter wet. June to September. 30cm.

Echeveria 'Ramillette': neat green rosettes, orange & yellow flowers in spring. Tender. 16cm. £5.00

Echeveria rosea: hardy succulent, leaves flush red in winter, spikes of yellow flowers April/May. 20cm £7.00

Epimedium 'Pink Champagne': very pretty two-tone red pink flowers, young leaves splashed red. May/June. 30cm. £7.00

Erigeron annuus: white daisy flowers in elegant panicles which weave their way amongst neighbouring plants, very long-flowering from July. 1.2m £7.00

Erigeron karvinskianus 'Lavender Lady': pale lavender flowers for a very long season, very tolerant of dry conditions. £6.00

Eriogonum crocatum: saffron buckwheat, sulphur yellow flowers over grey foliage, very tolerant of heat & drought. 20cm. £7.00

Eriogonum grande var. *rubescens*: heads of pink or red flowers over grey-green foliage, tolerant of sun & drought. 20cm. £7.00

Erodium chrysanthum: pale sulphur yellow flowers, for sun & well-drained soil. 10cm. £6.00

Eryngium alpinum: the *Eryngium* with the largest, bluest flower heads, requires moist, well-drained soil to thrive. June/July. £7.00

Eryngium bourgatii: metallic blue thistle flowers over spiny silver leaves. June/July. 60cm. £7.00

Eryngium planum: metallic blue flowers, soft leaves. June/July. 60cm. £7.00

Erysimum 'Apricot Twist': orange flowers in April/ May, scented. 30cm. £7.00

Erysimum 'Audrey's Pink': very pretty pale pink flowers. May/June. 30cm. £7.00

Erysimum 'Bredon': yellow flowers, grey green leaves, scented, compact grower. May/June. 30cm. £7.00

Erysimum 'Harpur Crewe': heritage variety, double yellow flowers in Spring. £7.00

Erysimum 'Parish's': reddish purple flowers for a long season, for sun & well-drained soil. March to May. 30cm. £7.00

Erysimum scoparium: purple flowers in spring, this hardy Canary Island endemic is one of the parents of 'Bowles' Mauve'. £7.00

Eucrosia 'Harry Hay hybrid': this is a tropical bulb with extraordinary flowers like a mophead. Winter dormant. Offsets. 60cm. £7.00

Euphorbia 'Abbey Dore': low growing glaucous leaves, lime green flowers. Leaves are broader than those of 'Blue Haze'. May/June. 30cm. £6

Euphorbia 'Blue Haze': low growing glaucous leaves, lime green flowers, very tolerant of drought. May/June. 20cm. £6.00

Euphorbia characias wulfenii: grey-green evergreen foliage, acid yellow flowers March to July. 90Cm £10.00 (2 litre pots)

Euphorbia deflexa: narrow leaves, tolerant of dry conditions. March to May. 20cm. £6.00

Euphorbia epithymoides 'Golden Fusion': showy golden-green flowers in spring, two weeks earlier than 'Midas' £7.00

Euphorbia epithymoides 'Midas': reportedly the best form of this herbaceous species, showy golden-green flowers in spring. £7.00

Euphorbia margalidiana: drought-tolerant evergreen species. April to June. 60cm. £8.00

Euphorbia x *martini* 'Helen Robinson': hybrid between *Euphorbia characias* & *Euphorbia amygaloides* var. *robbiae*. Lime green flowers in summer. £8.00.

Euphorbia myrsinites: low-growing herbaceous species, grey green leaves. March/April. 15Cm height x 40cm spread. £7.00

Euphorbia nereidum: large growing herbaceous species for a sheltered position. April to June. 1.6m. £8.00

Euphorbia x *pasteurii*: a hybrid from *mellifera*, shorter & more spreading & the leaves rather broader. Again, honey-scented flowers in spring, slightly later than the *mellifera* parent. 70cm £8.00

Euphorbia pithyusa 'Ponte Lecce': narrow grey-green leaves on this small shrub to about 60cm. £7.00

Euphorbia 'Redwing': green-yellow flowers follow on from red buds, dark foliage. Neat & compact. 60cm. PBR £7.00

Euphorbia x *sharmanii*: evergreen hybrid between *ceratocarpa* & *margalidiana*. For sun & well-drained soil, drought tolerant. 60cm. May to September. £8.00

Euphorbia stygiana var. *sanctae-mariae*: this is a very rare tree-forming (or rather tall shrub: but it grows on a single stem) variety of the Azores native. Honey-scented flowers in spring. May. To 3m in a sheltered situation. £8.00

Fragaria 'Pink Panda': bright pink flowers in spring followed by the occasional strawberry. March to May. 20cm £7.00

Fuchsia 'Ceri': almost hardy, masses of flowers, pale pink corolla, pink tube & sepals. Bushy. 40cm. £7.00

Geranium 'Dreamland': pale silvery pink flowers over grey green leaves, flowers May to November. 20cm £7.00

Geranium 'Lakwijk Star': purple flowers in early summer, good autumn colour on the leaves. £7.00

Geranium 'Mavis Simpson': pale pink flowers (slightly less pink & a little smaller than 'Dreamland'), May to November. 20Cm £7.00

Geranium x monacense: deep maroon flowers May/June. 70cm. £7.00

Geranium x oxonianum 'Something Special': mid-pink flowers, leaves attractively marked. 60cm. £6.00

Geranium 'Pink Delight': traversii hybrid, pale pink flowers over silvery leaves. May to September. 20cm. £7.00

Geranium phaeum 'Waterer's Blue': blue flowers in early summer £7.00

Geranium phaeum 'Wendy's Blush': pale flowers with a deeper blue eye in early summer. £7.00

Geranium pratense 'Marshmallow': pale pink flowers over dark purple foliage, May to July. 60cm £7.00

Geranium 'Prelude': many small mauve flowers, May to September. 40cm £7.00

Geranium 'Russell Prichard': carmine flowers over slightly silvery leaves, flowers May to October. 30cm £7.00

Geranium schlechteri: silver pink flowers, silvery cut leaves. May/ June. 30cm £7.00

Geranium 'Tinpenney Mauve': derived from G. clarkei this has mauve flowers for a long period from May. 60cm. £7.00

Geum 'Flames of Passion': semi-double red flowers hang from tall stems. May to July. 60cm £7.00

Geum 'Lemon Delight': nodding lemon yellow flowers, May to July. 60cm. £7.00

Geum 'Lisanne': yellow flowers. May to July. 40cm. £7.00

Geum magellanicum: red flowers over a compact plant, May to July. 30cm. £7.00

Geum 'Mandarin': semi-double flowers, bright orange. Long flowering, May to July. 60cm £7.00

Geum 'Proud's Pearl': single white flowers, May/June. 30cm £7.00

Geum 'Turnover': new variety from Dave Knox, nodding salmon-red flowers, May/June. £7.00

Gladiolus 'David Hills': hardy red-flowered papilio hybrid, increases quickly. June/July. 80cm. £7.00

Gladiolus 'Marina': brown-orange flowers in July/August. 80cm. £7.00

Gladiolus papilio 'Dark Ruby': dark red hooded flowers on this hardy variety. June/July. 70cm. £7.00

Glandularia 'La France': lavender coloured flowers all summer. 20cm. £6.00

Glandularia 'Silver Anne': pale pink/ white bicolor flowers all summer. 20cm. £6.00

Glandularia 'Sissinghurst': bright pink flowers. 20cm. £6.00

Gypsophila zeghulensis: clouds of small pink flowers above grey-green foliage, tolerant of dry conditions. 40cm. July/August. £7.00

Halimium halimifolium: silver-leaved evergreen shrub, yellow flowers with brown central blotches. For sun & well-drained soil. May/June. 70cm. £10.00

Halimium x tardiflorens: the showiest Halimium, largest yellow flowers, blotched at the base; silvery leaves. 70cm. £10.00
