"Ready for the Times to Get Better"

I am happy to say, after much planning and preparing, we will open the Clifton Arts Center facility to the public in July. We strongly suggest, you plan your visit by making reservations 24 hours in advance call 973-472-5499 or e-mail rcammilleri@cliftonnj.org. The health and safety of staff and visitors is our top priority. Please stay at home if you are feeling sick or have any COVID symptoms.



During the initial re-opening plan, we are following the reopening of Clifton City facilities guidelines and protocols to the public by City Administration. New measures and procedures have been implemented as part of the trusted space program for staff and visitors' health and safety. These protocols include the following: encouraging reservations, requiring to wear face coverings, to undergo temperature checks prior to entry, sign-in sheet including visitor's name, telephone/e-mail, while moving about maintaining physical distance and implementing increased frequency of sanitization and disinfection. Hand-sanitizing stations are available and restrooms have been upgraded with touchless fixtures. More detailed information will be posted at www.cliftonartscenter.org.

At any time, procedures and protocols may change. Again, we encourage you to plan your visit and make the most of your time by being prepared and know what to expect. The new hours open to the public in order to continue the flow through the building with health safety guidelines in mind and keep up with increased frequency of sanitization and disinfection are:

For timeframe: Week of July 6th until August 21st
Thursdays from 11am-5pm and Saturdays from 11am- 5pm

During this time, you can visit in person the exhibit "World Travel in Art" by Clifton Association of Artists in the Gallery Wing and "A Rocketry Model Garden" by George Scarfo in the Studio Wing. Also, throughout the 26-acre property you can visit the outdoor Sculpture Park and see the various sculptures.
