The Clifton Arts Center and Sculpture Park is a branch of the City of Clifton Health/Human Services Department designated to serve the well-being of the citizen through various cultural arts and educational programs to the local community. Our Current Exhibit: *Painting Through the Pandemic*

The Clifton Arts Center presents "Painting Through the Pandemic" by the Painting Affiliates of the Art Center of Northern New Jersey, an art exhibit and sale of artwork. The exhibit opens on Thursday, November 4th, and ends on Saturday, December 11th.

Please note that the Arts Center is closed on Thanksgiving Day.

The Painting Affiliates is a group of regional artists who work independently and join to exhibit together in the metropolitan area. Founded in 1970, the group seeks to build community appreciation of contemporary art without representing any particular style of school. Members meet to exchange ideas, stimulate new thinking, solve problems and provide creative support. Their group shows have been held at the Newark Museum, The Morris Museum, the Bergen Museum of Art and Sciences, Nabisco World Headquarters, Johnson & Johnson, Volkswagen, and Valley National Bank.

The Painting Affiliates is one of four groups associated with the Art Center of Northern New Jersey, which provides art training for all ages and as well as year-round exhibits.

Sculpture Park



The Clifton Arts Center & Sculpture Park has added a new sculpture to the park by artist, Elaine Lorenz . The sculpture is: "Windswept Separation". The Clifton Sculpture Park is free and **open from Dawn to Dust**. It is located on the grounds of Clifton Municipal Complex.

The sculpture piece of "Windswept Separation" reflects her observation of certain landforms in the American southwest and the weathering processes that produces them. As she states, "I am attracted to the evidence of different layers of sandstone as well as the knife-edge lines created by wind and water. I created two shapes with space in between to suggest canyons and caves, which are also carved out of the mesas. These sculptural forms always draw me to explore them. I wanted to create a sculpture that allows viewers to enter and experience that feeling of exploration and being engulfed by the form."

The material she mostly used to create the sculpture is found Styrofoam packing material, covered with stucco and acrylic paint. As Herrat states, "It holds up very well in all kinds of weather. I get a great deal of satisfaction using recycled material and giving it an unexpected colorful new life."
