"Lights Out" Chamber Musicians



FRANCESCA ARNONE—FLUTE

Francesca Arnone is an active flute and piccolo soloist, chamber musician, and educator dedicated to connecting to people through music. An avid traveler, she enjoys pursuing this passion, performing in Europe, Asia, and the Americas in such venues as St. Martin-in-the-Fields, National Sawdust, Royal Northern College of Music, Royal Conservatory of Madrid, Benedetto Marcello Conservatory in Venice, Split Academy of Music in Croatia, and the Chicago Public Library.

A featured guest artist at flute festivals around the country, she has performed at a variety of flute conventions and festivals, including those of the National Flute Association, British Flute Society, International Flute Festival of Costa Rica, and the Flute Society of Spain. Her solo and chamber music recordings on the MSR and Ravello labels have met critical acclaim. A veteran of regional and opera orchestras in the US and Mexico, she now performs with a variety of orchestras and ensembles across Florida, and is a member of the Palm Beach Opera Orchestra and the Sarasota Opera Orchestra. Her concerto appearances on flute, alto flute, and piccolo have ranged from works by Bach to Chen Yi.

Dr. Arnone has served on the faculties of Baylor, West Virginia, Boise State, and Idaho State universities. She teaches at the University of South Florida in Tampa, and at FlootFire and other summer camps around the country. Former students hold performing and leadership positions with ensembles such as the Boston Symphony, Atlanta Symphony, and the President's Own, and as teachers and professors at numerous schools and colleges around the country.



AMY COLLINS—OBOE

Amy Collins has served as adjunct Professor of Oboe at The University of South Florida since 2004. She leads a diverse and active career as a performer and educator throughout the greater Tampa Bay area. In addition to teaching applied oboe she is the founder and director of the USF annual Da' "Bull" Reed Summer Camp, begun in 2003. Collins is also on the faculty at Hillsborough Community College, Florida College, Eckerd College and The Pinellas County Center for the Arts High School located in St. Petersburg, Florida. Prior to her appointment at USF, Collins was on the faculty at The University

of Tampa.

Collins has appeared throughout the United States and globally as both a performer and educator. She spends her summers on the faculty of The Governors School for the Arts in Tennessee and teaches and performs in several summer music festivals throughout Europe. She performs regularly with a myriad of ensembles in the Tampa Bay area including as Principal Oboist in both The Venice Symphony and The Villages Philharmonic.

Collins also regularly plays for the numerous touring Broadway productions that come through Tampa. Collins has played with The New York City Opera Company, Miami City Ballet Company, Joffrey Ballet, The Moisiev Ballet, Mannheim Steamroller, Cirque de Sole, and with such greats as Andrea Bocelli, Luciano Pavarotti, Tony Bennett, Diana Ross, Josh Groban, Lindsey Stirling, and Evanescence to name a few. She was honored in the Fall of 2007 to perform for Pope Benedict XVI at the Vatican in Rome, Italy, where she made history as being the first instrumentalist to perform in the Basilica of St. Peters since Pope John Paul I. Collins is president of her own business; The Stellar Corporation, Inc. dba Stellar Oboe Products. Now, The Stellar Corporation, Inc. celebrates over twenty-five years in business.



TONY NEGRON—CLARINET

A native to Tampa Bay, Tony Negron has enjoyed a richly varied career as a professional clarinetist, chamber musician, concerto soloist, and as an educator. He graduated from the University of South Florida with a Bachelor's in Music Education and from Duquesne University with a Masters in Clarinet Performance, where he studied with Ron Samuels of the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra.

As a performer, Tony serves as principal clarinet with the Florida Wind Band and second clarinet with the Greenville Symphony

Orchestra & Florida Philharmonic Orchestra (previously the Punta Gorda Symphony). He has performed with The Florida Orchestra, Orlando Philharmonic, Sarasota Orchestra, and Disney Candlelight Orchestra. Tony has won several competitions, including first place in the Robert Shankovich Wind Ensemble Concerto Competition with Scott McAllister's *Black Dog.* He has been a featured soloist with Alia Musica Pittsburgh, both the Duquesne Symphony Orchestra & Wind Ensemble, the Florida Wind Band, served as a resident artist with the Master Chorale of Tampa Bay, and has been a featured artist on Pittsburgh's Classical Music Radio Station WQED 89.3. Tony has also performed alongside notable musical acts including Celtic Thunder, the Italian pop opera trioll Volo, Il Divo, and with Sarah Brightman during her Hymn World Tour.

Outside of his performance duties, Tony is highly sought after for lessons, masterclasses, lectures, and presentations. Tony teaches clarinet at Hillsborough Community College, Eckerd College, and has served as Clarinet Professor on the woodwind facultyat the 2018, 2019, & 2024 Clazz International Music Festival held in Arcidosso, Italy. He has presented at the Florida Music Educator's National Conference, at the University of South Florida, and has presented masterclasses throughout the Tampa Bay area, including his lecture series titled *The Mosaic Musician*. He maintains a strong and active private studio, teaching between 40-50 students weekly. Tony was named the 2017 Rising Star in Music Education from the Hillsborough County Elementary Music Educators Council.



IOHN MCCOLLEY—HARP

John McColley was born and raised in the Tampa Bay area, and one of his greatest pleasures is bringing fabulous music to his community. John earned a Bachelor of Music in Harp Performance from Baldwin Wallace University's Conservatory of Music and a Master of Music in Harp Performance and Pedagogy from the University of Colorado at Boulder. John's principal teachers include Jody Guinn of the Cleveland Orchestra, Janet Harriman of Opera Colorado and Central City Opera, and Anna Kate Mackle of The Florida Orchestra.

John serves as adjunct harp faculty at the University of South Florida, University of Tampa and Hillsborough Community College. In addition, John is the Director of Harp Studies for Hillsborough County Public Schools, where he teaches harp from 4th to 12th grade. The Hillsborough County Harp program is one of the oldest, and largest, public school harp programs in the country and serves as a model for other school districts looking to recreate its unique success.

On top of his teaching duties, John is an active performer. He is the principal harpist of the St. Petersburg Opera Company and the Florida Wind Band. He is also a frequent substitute and additional harpist with orchestras across Florida and beyond. John's main passion and musical focus are aimed at 20th and 21st century chamber music. He is the Principal Harpist of the Reflections Chamber Ensemble, which advocates for and specializes in chamber music of now and the last hundred years. John has commissioned and premiered multiple new chamber works for harp and other instruments. He is considered an authority on the music for and performance of the Flute, Harp, and Viola trio. His trio, The Barefoot Trio, was featured by The World Harp Congress in its concert celebrating new music for the harp.






