Both of these problems pose serious risks to future generations as well as to the ecosystem and climate. I'm attempting to change and impart a significant worth through my composition.



His accolades include a Bronze Medal at the Sambhavna Kala Manch Art Exhibition in 2020 and the 87th All India Cash Award from the Hyderabad Art Society in 2019. Currently, he is the Graphic Studio In-charge at Arths hila – Parivartan in Siwan, Bihar.

I grew up in a rural area, which fostered my deep appreciation for nature. Over the years, I have observed the ongoing destruction of nature's beauty by society. Through my art, I aim to highlight these changes and express the shift from concrete forms to abstraction, reflecting contemporary feelings that often go unnoticed.

My paintings portray abstract shapes inspired by natural elements like fields, forests, clouds, stones, and rocks, utilizing horizontal lines and dots. My creative process focuses on exploring abstract concepts, where I create textures and shapes by soaking cloth strips in ink or colors on paper or canvas, often working in monochrome.





I once found the foundation of an abandoned house more intriquing than an idyllic nearby waterfall."










