Odisha, INDIA. She studied B.V.A. in B.K. College of art & crafts, BBSR and completed her M.V.A. in Utkal University of Culture, BBSR, Odisha in 2015. She currently lives and works in Delhi.

The beauty of nature and our culture is revealed in my painting. It describes the truth and progression of time, as well as human nature, nature, culture, and geographical and climate changes. The language of realism focuses on shifting between my early childhood surroundings and coping with the present human civilization and changing cultural norms. My art is highly colourful and heavily allegorized. My plan focuses on prior societal norms, culinary traditions, rural landscapes, and socio-cultural trends. I'm concentrating on the problems with inorganic farming and the ecosystem on our planet. Both the loss of many of these forests and the increased use of pesticides and other chemicals for harvesting go hand in hand. Both of these problems pose serious risks to future generations as well as to the ecosystem and climate. I'm attempting to change and impart a significant worth through my composition.






