Arunanshu's artistic journey began in childhood when he spent time with his grandmother, crafting small sculptures from kneaded dough in the kitchen. Growing up in a household where his mother was both an artist and an art teacher, he naturally painted for fun and gradually refined his skills over the years. Though he never initially planned to pursue art education, he eventually did so. He moved from Patna to Baroda fine arts, drawn by its reputation as the ideal place to turn his passion for art into a full-time career. Over time, his style evolved from traditional watercolors to powerful, expressive brushwork on large canvases, drawing inspiration from diverse sources. Today, he continues to explore mixed media, sculpture, and ambitious large-scale works that reflect themes related to his city, contemporary politics, and personal experiences.

I come from a carpenter family. My roots are in a small village. I spent summers with my grandfather, who worked with wood. He taught me about different types of wood. This knowledge changed my perception of wood's texture. To me, wood is a living presence. In Hindu tradition, wood is a lifelong companion. It's used in daily life, from homes to rituals. Wood has many benefits. It's renewable, reduces pollution, and connects humans with nature. It supports mental well-being and health. Millions rely on wood for livelihoods. It's a versatile and familiar natural resource. Wood has been valued for its accessibility, functionality, and beauty. For me, wood symbolizes life. It connects us to nature and human existence. I observe patterns and textures when cutting logs, which become metaphors in my work. My art explores human existence and our bond with nature. I use visual elements to express emotions. Wood is essential in my artistic practice.

Uma Shankar Pathak, Artist

Animals in my work serve as symbolic elements exploring desire, aspiration, and the tension between stability and instability. Motifs like homes and monuments reflect the human quest for lasting goals, while pieces such as Tiger, Zebra, and Birds contrast organic forms with urban chaos, highlighting the clash of past and present. My art—acrylic on canvas or other media—offers a calm, thought-provoking experience. I hold a BFA from Patna University and an MFA from Venkateshwara Open University, and have received awards including recognition from the Red Cross Society of South Korea. I've exhibited widely in India and internationally, including at Aapsa Art, Lalit Kala Akademi, Apparao Art Gallery, Trinity Art Gallery, and MOMUS, Greece. I currently live in New Delhi.

My paintings blend urban and rural imagery, capturing the movement and tension of migrant laborers. Using abstract forms, I explore the clash between city rigidity and rural simplicity streetlights and zebra crossings against the ploughshare, a symbol of "nothing in everything." This reflects my own journey as a migrant from farming roots, shaped by unfulfilled hopes and the endless pursuit of dreams. In Expecting the Expectation, I question what expectation truly means, inspired by childhood memories of planes flying past my kitchen window symbols of both wonder and distance. In The Blackest Air, I express the sorrow of progress at nature's cost: polluted air representing the damage of our insatiable desires.

Born in 1973 in Jaunpur, UP, I completed my schooling up to class 12 there. I earned a BFA (1996) and MFA (1998) in Visual Arts from BHU Varanasi. In 1999, I joined the National Lalit Kala Kendra in Lucknow as an independent artist—a role I've held for 32 years.

My journey in this field has been both enjoyable and rewarding, marked by numerous accomplishments—such as three National Awards from All India Fine Arts and Crafts in New Delhi, a State Award from the Uttar Pradesh State Lalit Kala Akademi in Lucknow, a Senior Fellowship and a Junior Fellowship from the Department of Culture and Tourism, a research grant from the National Lalit Kala Akademi in New Delhi, and scholarships from both the Saraswati Foundation of Arts and Culture and the State Lalit Kala Akademi in Lucknow. In addition, I have actively participated in numerous national and international exhibitions, attended over twenty artist workshops, and engaged in various cultural activities. I have also taught for three years at Chhatrapati Sahu Ji Maharaja University in Kanpur and for three years at Lucknow University.
