Address: 114 Kraft Street, Building D, Clarksville, TN

FROM INTERSTATE 24

From Nashville / South:

Take I-24 West and exit at Exit 8 – Rossview Road / Hankook Road, turn LEFT onto Rossview Road.

From Kentucky / North:

Take I-24 East and exit at Exit 8 – Rossview Road / Hankook Road, turn RIGHT onto Rossview Road.

From either direction:

Follow Rossview Road and turn LEFT onto Dunbar Cave Road at the traffic light.

Continue on Dunbar Cave Road for approximately 4 miles. At the second traffic light, turn LEFT onto Wilma Rudolph Boulevard.

After approximately 1 mile, you will cross the Red River. The road becomes College Street after the bridge.

Continue on College Street and look for Larry's Nursery and a large silver "M" on your RIGHT. Turn RIGHT at the silver "M."

The Clarksville Kennel Club Training Building is directly ahead. We are located to the left of All God's Creatures Veterinary Clinic.

FROM WITHIN CLARKSVILLE

We are located at the intersection of Kraft and College Streets in the Kraft Street Complex. You enter the complex by turning off of College Street at the large silver "M" next to Larry's Nursery. We are located to the left of All God's Creatures Veterinary Clinic.

Refunds

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund will be made. The club may cancel the events due to extreme weather conditions.

No entry fee may be returned after entries close, except that of a bitch that comes in season after being entered. Bitches that come in season will have their entire entry fee returned upon notification. For injured dogs, a refund less \$5 per entry will only be issued if the Test Secretary receives a veterinarian's Certificate or letter to this effect at least ½ hour prior to the start of the test(s). No refunds for overpayment of fee will be made for amounts of \$5 or less.

Notice to Exhibitors

Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and themselves in and around the building and parking area.

By providing an email address on the entry form, you agree to electronic correspondence for confirmation letter and judging program. If you would like your confirmation letter and judging program sent via US Postal Service, you may either not provide your email address on your entry or you may specifically request USPS.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Bitches in season: Bitches that come in season will have their entire entry fee returned upon notification.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

It is the responsibility of the person submitting the entry form to ensure accuracy of data on the entry form. In the event of errors or cancellation, no refund will be given after the published closing date.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Dogs will be tested in order that entries are received. Pre-Entries will have precedence over Day-Of Entries

Ribbons will be awarded to each dog passing the Temperament Test.

TEST HOURS: 8:00 am to 5:00pm.

You will be expected to have complete info for your dog.
